HOMEOWNER INPUT:

- ➤ Discussed whether Pima county is responsible for maintaining the drainage ditches. County responsibility extends from the south border of Lot 151. The HOA is attempting to transfer maintenance of the channel area along Lot 151 to Pima County, but, so far, without success.
- > Homeowner noted that there are several homeowners neglecting to put their garbage cans away
- ➤ Mr. Harper presented a complaint from a homeowner that Mr. Harper has purchased a hauler that looks like a Semi truck. Mr. Harper explained that the CC&Rs state that RVs are permitted and that his vehicle is an RV hauler and is not being used as a commercial vehicle. The issue was brought to the board regarding this. Mr. Harper pointed out that the vehicle is in compliance with the regulations of the state of Arizona ,and that it meets all regulations for both AZ and Montana, as well as the CC&Rs.
- ➤ Discussed ATV's around homes and the noise this is causing. It was pointed out that this is a County issue since the ATVs do not originate in Star Valley. There is a need to identify the perpetrators if at all possible. Video cameras were suggested.

NEW BUSINESS:

➤ Discussed transparency regarding the reimbursement to homeowners. Mr. Williamson would like to have all homeowner refunds to be published. It was pointed out that this information is sensitive in nature since it contains listings of delinquency. The refund distribution information will not be made available. It was pointed out that the formula used to determine each homeowner's refund was published in advance in the Polaris Beacon and also included as a cover letter along with the refund check.

> Switch from bimonthly to quarterly board meetings.

MOTION by Mr. Blankenbaker to switch from bimonthly to quarterly board meetings **SECONDED** by Mr. Harper

Discussion: Board will have Five meetings, four being normal board meetings and one meeting for the annual meeting and election of officers. Meetings will occur on the 2nd Thurs. of the first month of each quarter (Jan, April, July, and October). The Annual meeting will be held during the first quarter on the 2nd Thurs. of March. Discussion ensued that if something important requiring immediate action were to come up, a notice of a special meeting would be sent out to all homeowners stating location, date and time. These meeting changes will be published on the website as well as the in the Polaris Beacon.

PASSED three to one.

MOTION by Mr. Blankenbaker to approve written Mission Statement for the Star Valley Board of Directors. The Mission Statement was read aloud to board and homeowners

SECONDED by Mr. Harper

During discussion, modifications of the wording were proposed.

AMENDMENT: Mr. Blankenbaker moved to accept the Mission Statement with corrections as given below:

The Mission of the Board of Directors of Star Valley Estates Homeowners Association shall be to:

Provide fair and equal treatment to every homeowner in the enforcement of the rules of the HOA.

Manage the common area of Star Valley to best suit the neighborhood without wasting any assets of the community.

Enhance the value of our properties by enforcement of the rules all homeowners accepted when they purchased their homes.

<u>SECONDED</u> by Mr. Harper **Amendment PASSED** unanimously

- Discussed the possibility of putting a wall/fence separating certain areas to prevent certain undesirables accessing common roads through private property. There has been approval of temporary fences in the past.
- Discussed the date of the refund checks that had been sent. There was approximately 40k dollars refunded to homeowners.

MOTION by Dr. Borom to remove Pat Linn from the ARC and replace her with Isaac Cañez **SECONDED** by Mr. Harper **PASSED** unanimously

MOTION by Mr. Harper to adjourn. **SECONDED** by Mr. Blankenbaker **PASSED** unanimously
