

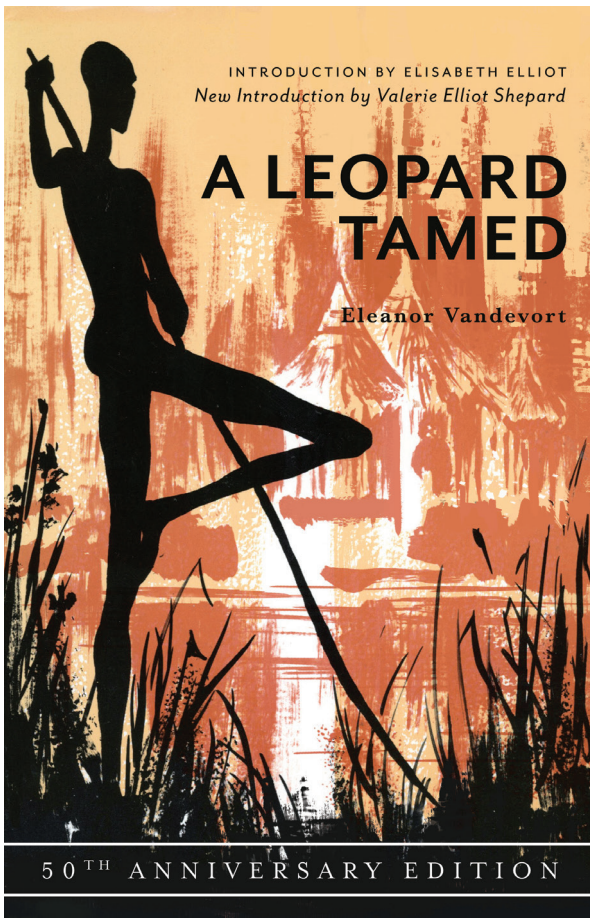

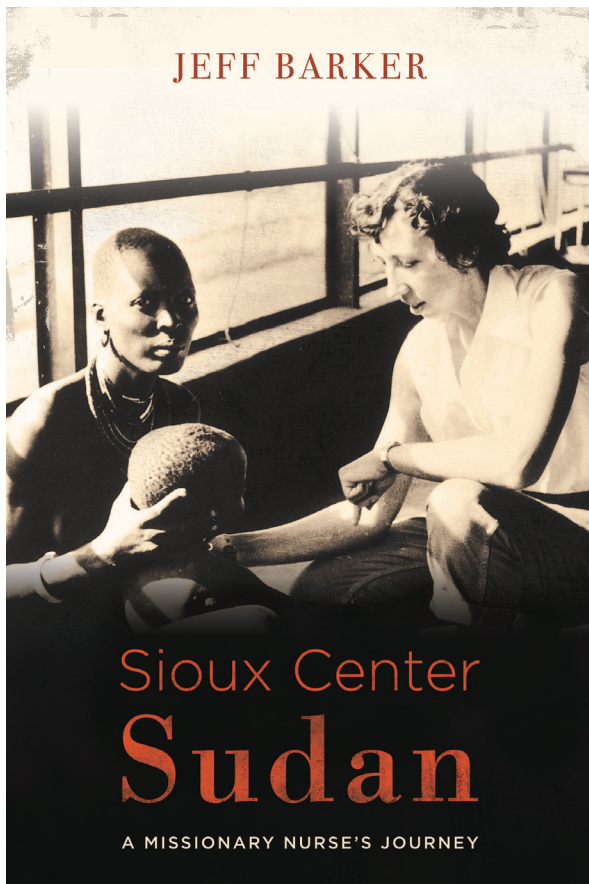

The story of *A Leopard Tamed* is set in Nasir, a tiny village on the banks of the Sobat River in the Sudan. It reads like the story of another world, of another time—but it is very much of our world, our time. The author is an American missionary who lived with the Nuer tribe in Nasir for thirteen years. *A Leopard Tamed* is the vivid, exciting description of what those years were like for her.

Eleanor became friendly with Kuac, a small boy whose burning ambition was “to do the work of God.” He proved invaluable in helping her. He taught her his language, which enabled her to translate the Bible for the Nuer people for the first time. After she discovered he was a born teacher, he even led Bible classes for her.

Although Kuac is the central figure in this engrossing narrative, it is also the story of the whole Nuer tribe. This book stirs the reader with strange tribal customs—such as the brutal rites initiating young boys into manhood; a typical native wedding; detailed description of housing, cooking, child-bearing, and so on. The author transports us to a land “that lies flat on its back, rolled out like a pie crust and crisscrossed with a network of footpaths linking village to village. The path is the highway in this land, covering hundreds and hundreds of miles, the imprint of a people who walk in order to communicate and who must communicate in order to live.”

Eleanor Vandevort (1925–2015), who earned her bachelor of arts in 1949 from Wheaton College, spent thirteen years in Sudan, Africa, in the village of Nasir, learning “the way of the people” and translating the Bible. Upon her return to the United States in 1963, she wrote *A Leopard Tamed* (published by Harper and Row in 1968), before beginning a twenty-one-year career at Gordon College as an academic advisor and mentor to students. She considered the testimony of God’s faithfulness, forged in the fire of Africa, to be the singular message of her life and ministry.

Arlene Schuiteman has a lifetime of stories to tell. They ramble across the Iowa fields of her farm-family childhood, they settle into the one-room schoolhouses that nurtured her first years of teaching, and they sweep away to Africa, where her gentle hands nursed thousands.

Sioux Center Sudan is the story of a missionary nurse's eight years on a tiny mission station in Nasir, Sudan, during the 1950s—the golden age of missions in America. There, Arlene faced immense challenges and yet learned to trust God in spite of the difficulties, including her unwanted expulsion from the country in 1963. Only decades later would she finally see the fruit of her work.

Filled with fascinating details of intense medical situations, stories of God's faithfulness, and periods of deep and personal grief, Arlene's journal entries could serve as a chapter in any textbook on the history of medical missions. Arlene's story also intersects with those of other contemporary women missionaries including Elisabeth Elliot, Eleanor Vandevort (*A Leopard Tamed*), and Betty Greene, pilot and cofounder of Missionary Aviation Fellowship. Quotes from letters between these women are included in the book.

Arlene Schuiteman (b. 1924) grew up during the Great Depression on a farm north of Sioux Center, Iowa. During World War II, she taught at a one-room school. Then she experienced a supernatural event that led her to Africa and a 33-year career as a public health nurse and teacher of nurses in the Sudan, Ethiopia, and Zambia. In 2005, Arlene met Jeff Barker, who eventually wrote a series of plays based on Arlene's amazing adventures.

Jeff Barker teaches theater and worship arts at Northwestern College and the Robert E. Webber Institute for Worship Studies. When not teaching, you can find him in a theater or on a film set, orchestrating story-focused worship for a local church or a national conference, or challenging his students to a game of chess.

Most of us who have studied Biblical Aramaic in seminary or graduate school find it difficult to read the Aramaic portions of the Bible with ease or solid comprehension. *Keep Up Your Biblical Aramaic in Two Minutes a Day* has been specially designed to help you read a small amount of Biblical Aramaic daily, in a manageable, enriching, and enjoyable way. It does not replace the need for a grammar or textbook; rather, it complements grammatical study by helping you to build a robust vocabulary and to review morphology and syntax in a completely inductive way, and without using any grammatical jargon. The page for each day presents:

- two new vocabulary words (for most of the book), with transliteration and definitions, beginning with the most common words and proceeding to the rarest
- the English text of a verse from Daniel or Ezra, with the day's two Aramaic words embedded in it, as they appear in the verse
- the Aramaic text of the verse, in full and then divided into phrases or clauses, with the corresponding English phrases or clauses next to them

More than one-third of the words in Biblical Aramaic appear only once in the Bible. When these *hapax legomena* begin to be presented in *Keep Up Your Biblical Aramaic in Two Minutes a Day* (about three-fifths of the way through the book), all that appear in a particular verse (whether this be one *hapax legomenon*, two, or several) are presented together as the new words for the day. The result is that—although there are 716 unique vocabulary words in Biblical Aramaic—by the time you reach the end of this book you will have seen every single one of these words. And during this process, you will have read most (about 80 percent) of the Aramaic verses found in the Bible!
