DOGMATIC'S AFTER BABEL: BEYOUND THE THEOLOGIES OF WORD AND CULTURE

ACADEMIC

This academic resource examines the division between theologies of culture vs. theologies of the Word. It also analyzes the three Abrahamic religions.


Rubén Rosario Rodríguez addresses the long-standing division between Christian theologies that take revelation as their starting point and focus and those that take human culture as theirs.

Rosario argues that in order to get beyond the impasse between theologies of the Word and culture, we need a different starting point. He discovers that starting point in two sources: (1) through the work of liberation and contextual theologians on the role of the Holy Spirit, and (2) through a comparative analysis of the teachings on the hiddenness of God from the three "Abrahamic" religions —Judaism, Christianity, and Islam.

Rosario offers a strong argument for why this third theological starting point represents not just a marginal or niche position but a genuine alternative to the two traditional theological streams. His work will shift readers' understanding of the options in theological discourse.

This book explores concepts from contemporary science to illuminate Scripture and reveal more about the God who has unfurled the multiverse. Sections of the book cover metaphors and parables from mathematics, physics, biology, and computer science.


Science is often presented as a set of propositions to affirm. On those terms, the existence of God becomes yet another such proposition, and all science can offer is a yes or a no. Andy Walsh thinks science offers more.

By enriching our language with new concepts, science can help us know God, rather than merely know of him. This is the pattern established in the Bible; the psalmists, the prophets, and the epistle writers all use language about nature to help us understand God. Even Jesus relied on metaphors from the natural world when he wanted to explain the kingdom of God.

- How can we better explore and understand the complicated work of reconciliation and justice?


This innovative approach to Christian ethics will benefit a new generation of students who wish to engage the perennial questions of what constitutes a faithful Christian life and a just society.

REFORMATION CELEBRATION: THE SIGNIFICANCE OF SCRIPTURE, GRACE, FAITH, AND CHRIST

Through multidiscipline essays ranging from Luther on Scripture, grace, and Christ to the implication today of the Christology of Athanasius and Calvin, this book offers a generous insight into how do the solas of the Reformation apply as we look at Scripture and work within the church to nurture the laity in their practice of faith?

This book is a result of the recent conference, "Reformation Celebration," at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary in South Hamilton, Massachusetts. Written and edited by Gordon-Conwell professors, its multidiscipline essays are ranging from Luther on Scripture, grace, and Christ to the implication today of the Christology of Athanasius and Calvin. Some of the important questions addressed—historically, theologically, and sociologically—include:

- What does sola scriptura (scripture alone) have to say about spiritual formation?
 What does Bible translation have to do with Christian mission?
- How do grace and works compare in Islam and Christianity?
- In what ways does sola gratia (grace alone) affect Christian counseling?
- How are social ethics shaped by sola gratia?
 How is sola de (faith alone) the foundation for ministry?
- In what way is solus Christus (Christ alone) related to Christian wholeness and maturity?

AUTHOR(S): GORDON L ISAAC is the Berkshire Associate Professor of Advent Christian Studies at Gordon-Conwell. He is also the coeditor of *Great Awakenings: Historical Perspectives for Today* (Hendrickson, 2016), and the author of *Prayer, Meditation, and Spiritual Trial: Luther's Account of Life in the Spirit* (Hendrickson, 2017).

THE FOUR PAGES OF THE SERMON, REVISED AND UPDATED: A GUIDE TO BIBLICAL PREACHING

A preacher's classic methodological guide, updated with significant new material. This completely revised edition guides readers through the sermon process step by step, with the aim of composing sermons that challenge and provide hope, by focusing on God more closely than on humans.

Doing justice to the complexity of the preaching task and the questions that underlie it, author Paul Scott Wilson organizes both the preparation and the content of the sermon around its "four pages." Each "page" addresses a different theological and creative component of what happens in any sermon. Page One presents the trouble or conflict that takes place in or that underscores the biblical text itself. Page Two looks at similar conflict – sin or brokenness – in our own time. Page Three returns to the Bible to identify where God is at work in or behind the text – in other words, to discover the good news. Page Four points to God at work in our world, particularly in relation to the situations described in Page Two. This approach is about preaching the gospel in nearly any sermonic form. Wilson teaches the 'what', 'why', and 'how' of sermon construction, all rooted in a theology of the Word.


It has been largely rewritten to include an assessment of where preaching is today in light of propositional preaching, the New Homiletic, African American preaching, the effect of the internet, and use of technology. A chapter on exegesis has been added, plus new focus on the importance of preaching to a felt need, the need for proclamation in addition to teaching, and developing tools to ensure sermon excellence. New sermon examples have been added along with a section that responds to critics and looks to the future.

SIDELINE CHURCH: BRIDGING THE CHASM BETWEEN CHURCHES AND CULTURES

Many churches will never be able to cross the chasm between churches and culture. When it comes to change, they will always worry more about members they might lose than strangers they might bless. However, some churches can and will cross that chasm. Those that do will discover that the key is empathy. It is empathy of the most intimate and profound kind. It is a true "heart burst" for someone other than vourself.

Most churches, regardless of their tradition, are now on the sidelines. They observe cultural change, but don't care to participate in it. Like spectators at a ball game, these churches watch. Occasionally churches will leave their seats to get a hot dog with their friends or quarrel with their enemies. Often today there are angry confrontations as liberals and conservatives shout insults at one another across the stadium. Churches become so preoccupied with what is going on in the stands that they pay less and less attention to the game. They project their own hopes and fears on individual players who become proxy representatives for a particular cause or policy.

If we were to reverse the metaphor and pretend that the spectators were actually players, we might see the game descend into chaos and become a brawl. Even more obvious, however, would be the empty stands. Fewer and fewer people are watching. The very spectacle of Christians brawling with each other has lost appeal. Nobody will buy tickets. The media won't bother to cover the game.
