CHRISTIANITY IN THE ROMAN EMPIRE: KEY FIGURES, BELIEFS, AND PRACTICES OF THE EARLY CHURCH (AD 100–300)

This thorough and well-written historical work introduces the reader to the religious identity of early Christians in the Roman Empire: what they believed and how they lived.

This is a topical and biographical introduction to Christianity before Constantine. While its focus is the historical development of the proto-orthodox community, Robert Winn aims to bridge the gap between contemporary Christians and those who lived in the Roman Empire. To do this, his chapters discuss particular topics such as prayer, biblical interpretation, worship, and persecution, as well as prominent and controversial individuals such as Ignatius of Antioch, Justin Martyr, Melito of Sardis, and Tertullian.

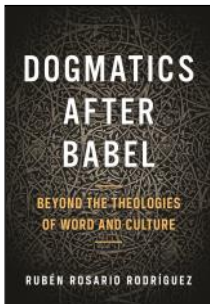
Winn guides us through the history of Christianity from the first century to the years before Constantine. Winn bridges the gap between contemporary Christians and those who lived in the Roman Empire from AD 100–300, with engaging discussion questions and in-depth details about controversial topics (such as persecution and biblical interpretation) and figures of the time (such as Perpetua and Felicity, and Justin Martyr). This book will provide you with a deeper appreciation for the early Christians as you learn about their struggle in the face of cultural and societal pressures to build the faith community we have today.

The text is arranged in three sections:

- 1) Christianity in the Year 100 - addresses the world of the apostolic fathers
- 2) Christianity in a Hostile World (100–250) - addresses hostility to Christianity and the response of Christians to this antagonism
- 3) Faith and Practice in the Third Century - addresses doctrinal and communal issues of the third century.

DOGMATICS AFTER BABEL: BEYOND THE THEOLOGIES OF WORD AND CULTURE

This academic resource examines the division between theologies of culture vs. theologies of the Word. It also analyzes the three Abrahamic religions.

Rubén Rosario Rodríguez addresses the long-standing division between Christian theologies that take revelation as their starting point and focus and those that take human culture as theirs.

Rosario argues that in order to get beyond the impasse between theologies of the Word and culture, we need a different starting point. He discovers that starting point in two sources: (1) through the work of liberation and contextual theologians on the role of the Holy Spirit, and (2) through a comparative analysis of the teachings on the hiddenness of God from the three "Abrahamic" religions—Judaism, Christianity, and Islam.

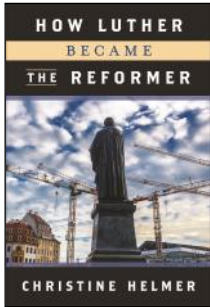
Rosario offers a strong argument for why this third theological starting point represents not just a marginal or niche position but a genuine alternative to the two traditional theological streams. His work will shift readers' understanding of the options in theological discourse.

HOW LUTHER BECAME THE REFORMER

No story has been more foundational to triumphalist accounts of Western modernity than that of Martin Luther, the heroic individual, standing before the tribunes of medieval authoritarianism to proclaim his religious and intellectual freedom, "Here I stand."

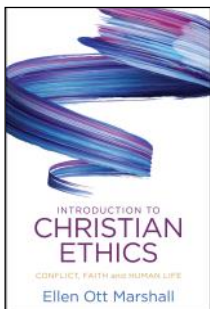
How Luther Became the Reformer returns to the birthplace of this origin myth, Germany in the late nineteenth century, and traces its development from the end of World War I through the rise of National Socialism. Why were German intellectuals—especially Protestant scholars of religion, culture, and theology—in this turbulent period so committed to this version of Luther’s story? Luther was touted as the mythological figure to promote the cultural unity of Germany as a modern nation; in the myth’s many retellings, from the time of the Weimar Republic forward, Luther attained world-historical status.

Helmer finds in this construction of Luther the Reformer a lens through which to examine modernity’s deformations, among them anti-Judaism, anti-Semitism, and anti-Catholicism. Offering a new interpretation of Luther, and by extension of modernity itself, from an ecumenical perspective, *How Luther Became the Reformer* provides resources for understanding and contesting contemporary assaults on democracy. In this way, the book holds the promise for resistance and hope in dark times.

- Shows the conception of modernity tied to Luther's biography as having its ugly side, specifically anti-Judaism and anti-Semitism, and Proposes a new understanding of modernity from an ecumenical-theological perspective.

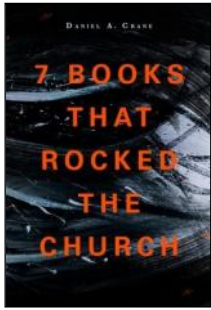

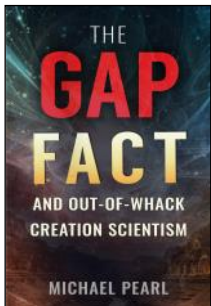

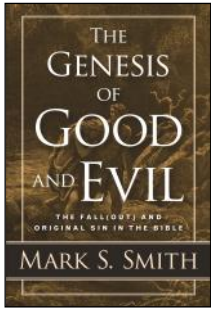
Well-known author Michael Pearl says it's time to expose the truth about the Gap Fact.

The largest project that NGJ has ever been involved in is the Good and Evil Project, a work to translate Mike's illustrated bible storybook *Good and Evil* (G & E) into 100 languages. In addition to the child training ministry, the work of the prison ministry, missions, and Bible studies, the Pearls have an active family life. They have been married since 1971; have 5 children, and 20 grandchildren.

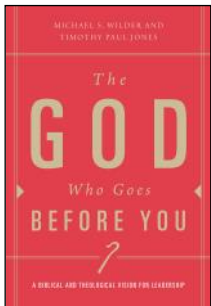
For centuries, the Garden of Eden story has been a cornerstone for the Christian doctrine of “the Fall” and “original sin.” In recent years, many scholars have disputed this understanding of Genesis 3 because it has no words for sin, transgression, disobedience, or punishment. Instead, it is about how the human condition came about.

Yet the picture is not so simple. The Genesis of Good and Evil examines how the idea of “the Fall” developed in Jewish tradition on the eve of Christianity.

In the end, the Garden of Eden is a rich study of humans in relation to God that leaves open many questions. One such question is, Does Genesis 3, 4, and 6, taken together, support the Christian doctrine of original sin? Smith’s well-informed, close reading of these chapters concludes that it does. In this book, he addresses the many mysterious matters of the Garden story and invites readers to explore questions of their own.

Smith is Helena Professor of Old Testament Literature and Exegesis at Princeton Theological Seminary and Skirball Professor Emeritus of Hebrew Bible and Ancient Near Eastern Studies at New York University. An award-winning author, Smith has written sixteen books, including *The Early History of God: Yahweh and the Other Deities in Ancient Israel*; *The Origins of Biblical Monotheism: Israel’s Polytheistic Background and the Ugaritic Texts*; *God in Translation: Deities in Cross-Cultural Discourse in the Biblical World*; *How Human Is God? Seven Questions about God and Humanity in the Bible*; and *Where the Gods Are: Spatial Dimensions of Anthropomorphism in the Biblical World*. His current research focuses on a commentary on the book of Judges, coauthored with archaeologist Elizabeth Bloch-Smith.

In the first half of his letter to these believers, Paul explains what it means to have a new identity in Christ. In the second half, he tells how to live in light of this identity. And while cultural dynamics may differ between the past and present and his geographical context ours, Paul’s words have great application for us today. Knowing who we are, our identity in Christ and what that means, is essential to how we live. So Earl Grey with Ephesians takes readers back to first-century Ephesus to explore the answers Scripture provides to the questions “Who am I?” and “What am I here for?” as well as how to live in light of these great realities. 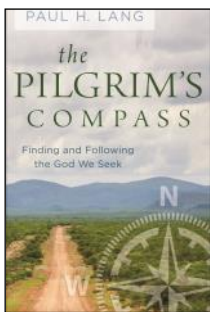
In *The Normal Christian Life*, Nee presents foundational principles for the Christian life and walk drawing primarily from the book of Romans. Nee reveals the secret of spiritual vitality that should be the normal experience of every Christian. Watchman Nee gave four steps in which a Christian lives the Christian life:

1. First, there is the need for the knowledge of the cross of Christ as a fact in our experience.
2. The second step is the matter of reckoning. Reckoning is the stating and considering of facts and promises that God has revealed to be true.
3. The third step is the matter of presenting to God. Coming to Romans 6:13, Watchman Nee says that Christians consecrate that which passed through death and resurrection in the new creation. In this way, Christians would no longer live to themselves but to Christ because He has the full authority over their lives.
4. The fourth step is the matter of Walking after the Spirit. Firstly, walking after the Spirit does not refer to our "working" but of dependence on God's working and operation. Secondly, it refers to subjection. This means that the Christian life is the yielding of all the dictates of our flesh and be of subjection to the Spirit.

These requirements lead to a new vision for the preaching classroom, the rhythms of the preaching life, and the definition of what it means to be a good preacher.

A rise in anti-Semitism from the right side of the political spectrum has been accompanied by a different kind of anti-Semitism from parts of the left revolving around the state of Israel. Rabbi Evan Moffic provides a compelling discussion to help Christians understand this dangerous rise by working to address tough questions including:

- Why have Jews been the object of the most enduring and universal hatred in history?
- What is different between anti-Semitism in the past versus today’s culture?
- How, and in what forms, may it be carried out in the future?

Moffic considers the twenty-first century anti-Semitism and the historical pattern of discrimination to other groups that often follows new waves of discrimination against Jewish communities. With a hopeful and collaborative tone, he suggests actions for all people of faith to combat words and actions of hate while lifting up practical ways Christians and Jews can work together.

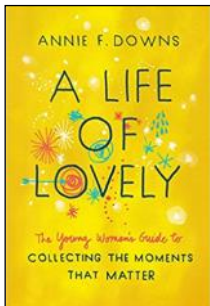
There are more than forty million enslaved people in the world today. This is overwhelming. A number so large leaves us asking, What could I even do to help?
