Course No.	Course Title & Description
3008	Theology & History of Christianity - Outline the development of the Christian movement from the beginning of Jesus' ministry on earth to present times. Focus on the history, theology, culture, and times that enable Christianity to develop and grow. Prominent persons who influenced the Christian movement will be identified.
7005	Christian Evangelism - Teach the basic steps in developing a program of evangelism. Discover the appropriate Scripture to use, and the methods, techniques, and media best suited for witnessing to nonbelievers.
7024	Discovering Your Spiritual Gifts - Help students to understand who God has uniquely made them to be. Work through a spiritual gift assessment that will help them to discover their spiritual gift(s) will prepare them to move into a meaningful area of service where they best fit into the body of Christ.
