# PROTECTING SURREY'S ROADS SURFACE TREATMENT TO PROLONG A ROAD'S LIFE

### What are we doing?

We are carrying out a road surface treatment trial on Guildford Road, Guildford. The road will be closed from Garden Close to the northern entrance of St John's Seminary whilst we carry out our works.

### Information for residents and businesses

As part of Surrey County Council's drive to improve the value and quality of its highway services, a new type of road surface treatment will be trialled on your road. 'Reclamite', has a three stage process outlined below:

- An oil based emulsion is applied to the road surface which sinks in to the asphalt within 30-40 minutes
- A layer of grit is then applied on top of the emulsion. The chippings help to prevent the emulsion being transferred onto car tyres.
- We aim to return 24 - 48 hours after the work is completed to sweep up the grit.

The emulsion stage can look untidy, but the appearance will improve once we've laid the grit. The surface needs 24 hours to settle before we can return to sweep the road. Within a few weeks the road surface will be back to its original colour. This type of treatment can extend the life of a road by up to four years.

So we can safely carry out these works we will have to close the road to all traffic. We will keep the length of time the road is closed to a minimum. Where possible we will work in sections to reduce the impact on residents.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. However, there may be short delays if we've just laid the emulsion. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

These works are weather dependent and may be delayed in wet weather. If we can't come on the first day of works please leave the road free of cars on the following day.

#### Parking and temporary reduced speed limit

It is essential to keep the road free from parked vehicles on the day of the treatment and when we return to sweep the road. Please park somewhere else otherwise your vehicle may be towed away to a nearby road. The speed limit of your road will be lowered to 20 miles per hour until after the road is swept.
