The Moose is a non-political and nonsectarian International Fraternal Lodge system, operating in the United States, Canada, Great Britain and Bermuda. It has a membership over one million men and women, with over 1800 lodges and 1500 chapters, most of which offer lodge facilities.

And the focal point of the campus is the magnificent House of God. Mooseheart maintains an accredited school system from nursery through high school. Greeneville Lodge is a proud supporter of Mooseheart and its continued success.
