For teachers who have a Clear 2042 Multiple or Single Subject Credential, Brandman allows up to a 12-credit transfer for the completion of a CTC approved induction program. For applicants with a CCTC Approved Preliminary Administrative service credential, Brandman awards up to 12-credits transfer into the program.

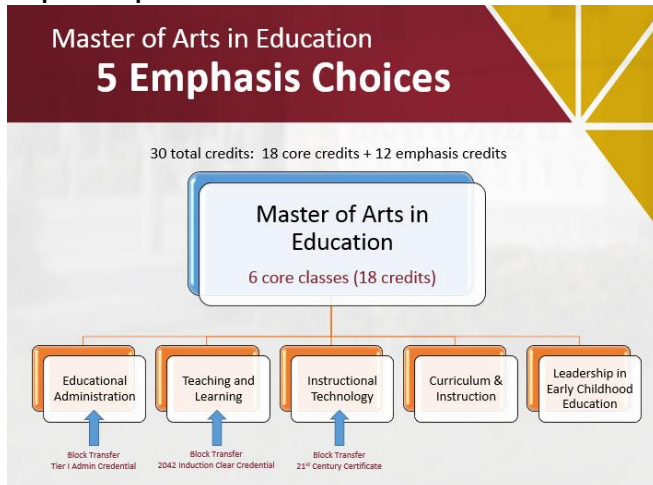

**Application Process / Requirements:**

1. Application

2. Statement of Intent
3. **Two** Recommendation Letters (Cannot be older than 2 years)
4. Official College Transcripts
5. Applicants to Teaching and Learning Emphasis, must have one year of induction completed or hold a valid Teaching credential earned through the CTC
6. Applicants to the MAE Educational Administration Emphasis, must hold a valid CCTC approved Preliminary Administrative Services Credential earned through the CTC. (if a student did the preliminary test out option, they will not be admitted)

Satisfactory completion of bachelor's degree or higher from a ***regionally accredited institution***

- Admission Grade Point Average Requirements (GPA)
  1. 3.0 or higher (BA) over most recent 30 graded semester units, including credits earned toward a credential.
