The Olde Towne Civic League and Portsmouth Master Cardeners took on the house's garden, where most of the teas are held.






circa 1820, is located in Olde Towne Portsmouth, Virginia. This magnificent home housed three generations of the Hill family.

It was home to three generations of Hills and in the 1960's was left to the PHA by its last occupant, Miss Evelyn Hill. Miss Hill left the contents of the home, which were acquired by all three generations to the PHA as well.

The Hill House Museum was opened to the public in the 1960's but around 2007 was closed due to badly needed restoration and maintenance.

In 2010, initiated by the PHA, there was a renewed effort to restore the home and its gardens to their original grandeur.
