

## Public Hearing Notice

Pursuant to Chapter 36, Texas Water Code, the Calhoun County Groundwater Conservation District will conduct a public hearing on March 21, 2018, 5:30 pm at the Coastal Center, 131 A Virginia St., Port Lavaca, Texas. This hearing will be conducted to receive public input concerning the proposed Rules of the District. The proposed rules specify the regulations related to registration and permitting of water wells, protection of historic use, water well spacing, groundwater production, well completion standards, fees, violations and enforcement, permit renewal and amendment, and administrative procedures. Revisions to the adopted Rules of the District address 1) the requirements related to submitting an application and proving ownership of groundwater; 2) clarify the concepts of owner of groundwater, authorized agent, well owner, and landowner; 3) define the concept of Special Groundwater Management Area and eliminate the concept of Production Limitation Management Areas; 4) revise well completion standards for wells with pit-less adapters; 5) modify the definition of exempt use well, administratively complete, and application; and 6) correct grammatical errors.
