### Tour Description

Enjoy the fantastic kayak adventure in Mechrey village - is a small less touristy floating village of Tonle Sap Lake. Religiously get ritual blessing from Buddhist monk and pray for good luck in life before the kayak tour begins, gently hand active through the pleasant mangroves (high water) and floating community to see how people make the lake as home, reveal lifestyle animated by fishing... and combined with silk farm.



### Detailed Itinerary

Our escort guide and driver will be meeting you at 8.30am at your hotel's lobby then heading out of the hassle Siem Reap city to **Puok silk farm** - observe the silk processing and see a lot of finest silk products displaying. Resume drive to **Mechrey village** of Tonle Sap Lake. The journey passes huge beautiful rice paddies dotting with palm trees and cattle in the fields before we arrive at Mechrey boat pier. Embark a sheltered boat cruising toward Mechrey **Buddhist pagoda** where we receive **ritual blessing** for good fortune in life, learn from your tour guide about **Tonle Sap ecosystem** and witness how life works in the **floating community** relying on aquatic resources before we begin the **kayaking adventure**, suddenly come across many interesting activities while passing by **floating houses** to the end of the village then we enjoy local lunch which prepared by a host.

Afternoon, we're active with the peddle to explore the **tranquil mangroves** (high water), gently kayak around and enjoy the surroundings, and capture picturesque photos before heading to our regular boat back to the mainland then transfer to your hotel and our guide and driver say Goodbye to you.

**Note:** In the low water (January – March), mangroves are not available. Alternatively, we kayak along Tonle Sap to see the largest freshwater lake and admired by some species of threaten waterbirds.

**Dressing Code**

Cambodia geographically stays in the tropical monsoon, its weather varies and annually brings wet and dry seasons, generally hot in during day time and a bit cooler at night, and in the early morning. You should wear whatever most comfortable. Shorts, T-Shirts, rubber shoes are highly recommended but shorts should be covered by scarf (Kroma) when we meet Buddhist monks for ritual blessing. Should bring along hat, sunscreen, insect repellent and extra bottled water.
