Peacefully, ride toward to witness the most beautiful, intricately carved Banteay Srei temple and admired by palm sugar village with various handicrafts.



Detailed Itinerary

Our escort guide will be meeting you at 8.00am at your hotel's lobby then we set off by our awaiting **mountain bikes** from the highlights of Siem Reap about 5km, experience the gentle ride on the dike overlooking **beautiful rice paddies** dotting **palm trees, cattle, ploughing** or **planting** activities and pass stilt houses from one village to others enhanced by "Hello" from friendly kids. We will have plenty of stops to take photos of interesting insights, observe rattan basket weaving and interact local people along with learning from your tour guide about their lifestyle and Cambodian culture. The bike adventure provides **wonderful cycling experience** on paved and dirt roads, see rural villages, Buddhist pagodas, mountainous landscape, and the tour is admired by ancient **Banteay Samre** temple before we stroll to witness the intricately carved, beautiful red-pink sandstone temple of **Banteay Srei** - considered to be a Jewel of Khmer art which features elaborate decorations and its finest details. These factors have made the temple extremely popular with tourists, and have led to its being widely praised as a "precious gem". After visit Banteay Srei, you may want to ride or take support vehicle on paved road back, we visit at **palm sugar village** and other various local handicraft souvenirs. Arrive hotel and driver say Goodbye to you.

Note: Sunset at Pre Rup temple is available when we're heading back to the hotel. Please just feel free to speak about this with our tour guide who will manage it for you.

Additional Tour Information

Angkor Entrance Fee

The entrance fee of Angkor archaeological park cost **\$37.00** for 1 day, **\$62.00** for 3 days valid within a week and **\$72.00** for 7 days valid within a month. The pass largely covers small/grand circuits and outside 2 circuits asuch Rolous Group, Banteay Samre, Kbal Spean, Banteay Srei, Athwea Temple & an ancient Phnom Krom temple except others are NOT mentioned (Beng Mealea...).

Importantly, for your trip, we reserve a local tour guide that has long-year experienced, friendly attitude, informative, knowledgeable, professional bike guide and advisable.

Lunch

Due to having a lot of complaining about expensive lunch & drinks at local restaurants near temple, we highly recommend you to book Khmer set lunch with us so that we can reserve a delicious set lunch for you in advance at one of good restaurants. We will provide a local beer or soft drink included in the set lunch price. Price is from \$9.50 to \$12.00 per person.

Transportation

During your bike trip, we provide a vehicle carrying support spare parts, equipment, first aid-kit, a cool box containing soft drinks, fruits and snacks and it's very useful when you don't want to ride the bike in the middle of the trip. Please be aware that the support vehicle isn't able to access all routes, meaning our tour guide will manage the driver to wait for us at suitable points. Make sure you always take a bottle of water with you before the vehicle leaves.

Dressing Code

Cambodia geographically stays in the tropical monsoon, its weather varies and annually brings wet and dry seasons, generally hot in during day time and a bit cooler at night, and in the early morning. You should wear whatever most comfortable but remember to dress appropriately to respect the locals and active religious sites;

pagodas, temples and holy places. To make it convenient when riding the bikes, we advise you to wear shorts, strong footwear, put on insect repellent (if necessary), sunscreen and hats.
