AACT role and budget:

- Stuart reported that AACT typically runs a surplus of ~\$4,000 a year with ~\$7000 p.a coming in from membership fees and expenses on administration and medals summing to around ~\$3000 p.a.
- It was suggested that proposals for budgetary items and AACT role definition be submitted electronically by the 15<sup>th</sup> March for consideration prior to the next meeting. Ian suggested that proposals should 'support officials, competitive and recreational archers' (definitely para-phrased).

# Team Selection Policy:

• Frances to look up the Archery Australia rules for teams in National events and distribute so that we can develop a policy for selection. To be discussed at the next meeting.

# **Other Business:**

- Matthew Satterthwaite tendered his resignation as CAC delegate to AACT.
- The meeting was informed that a number of CAC archers would be competing at the junior nationals. Ben Pawson was to accompany the team. It was decided:
  - Team members to be subsidised \$40 ea for the purchase of a team shirt
  - Ben be recognised as the ACT team manager and given a subsidised shirt
- It was noted that Paul Smith and Steve Caldicott completed a training course by Kisik Lee privately and under their own funding. It was proposed that AACT reimburse \$200 each for Paul and Steve under the proviso that they run a seminar on the course free for AACT members. AACT would cover costs (venue, copying).
