

# Archery ACT Society Inc.

AACT Team Selection Policy  
Effective: 1 September 2018

## **Overview**

This policy outlines the processes and procedures available for all archers intending to be a member of the Australian Capital Territory (ACT) Team competing at the Archery Australia National Championships in any given year.

## **Team Composition**

Teams will be selected for the following:

- a. Open Nationals:
  - a recurve team comprised of a maximum four (4) men and four (4) women; and
  - a compound team comprised of a maximum four (4) men and four (4) women; competing in any class
- b. Youth Nationals:
  - a recurve team comprised of a maximum of ten (10) archers; and
  - a compound team comprised of a maximum of ten (10) archers; inclusive of gender, classes and divisions
- c. Indoor Nationals:
  - a recurve team comprised of a maximum of four (4) archers; and
  - compound team comprised of a maximum of four (4) archers; inclusive of gender, class and divisions

as outlined and amended in the AA rules and/or policies, who are eligible to compete at the National Archery Championships in the given year; are selected and named as the Archery ACT Team.

Team members must agree to:

- Be and remain financial members of Archery ACT while on the team
- Compete in all events at the given tournament for which they are selected:
  - Open Nationals: both Target and Field events
  - Youth Nationals: all Target, Field and Clout events
- Shoot the bow type for the event they gained selection in
- Provide evidence of registration in the event
- Comply with all current tournament and shooting rules and team guidelines
- Adhere to the Athletes Code of Conduct
- Wear the AACT uniform
- Comply with team management directives at the event
- Attend sanctioned team events in the lead up to the National event
- Participate in AACT team activities unless excused
- Sign a Media Consent Form for the promotion of AACT
- Support the objectives of AACT.

## **Team Selection**

- The selection period will commence 12 months prior to the next relevant Championships.
- Closing date for applications will be announced by AACT in the given year, with general dates being approximately 12 weeks prior to the commencement of the tournament.
- Archers will be required to submit two (2) verified scores for each of the events used as part of the team competition at the relevant National Championships in the given year, in accordance with the table provided (see Appendix 1)
- Scores must be attained at a club, state, or nationally registered event with score sheets or Archers Diary to be added as a reference.
- Archers seeking submission into the team must complete and submit an application form (AACT Team Application Form – Appendix 2) to the Archery ACT secretary.
- Upon closing date of applications, a ranking of archers will be developed by combining submitted scores and collecting the average rating. This list will then be submitted to Archery ACT for ratification.
- Archery ACT will publish the application and ranking for team positioning within 72 hours of the “ranking cut-off” date
- Should an archer have to withdraw after the team is officially named, the same process will be used to try and fill that position if minimum requirements have been reached by the prospective replacement(s).
- Archers who do not attain scores as outlined in the table are still encouraged to submit an application form, as depending on numbers may be considered by the Archery ACT Society committee, for inclusion in the team; additionally, will be included in the group of representatives competing (see uniform section).

## **Team Captains**

- AACT invites selected archers to express their interest in holding the position of team captain by submitting an expression of interest in conjunction with their team application. (Appendix 2)
- The team captain will support all AACT archers including their team

## **Uniforms**

- The AACT team shooting uniform shall be worn at all times by Team Members in competition during the Indoor, Youth and/or Open national Championships. Breaches of this directive may result in sanctions, including loss of any financial reimbursements.
- Uniform consists of AACT approved shirt with name on the back, and black shorts/skirt/trousers
- Once the team is selected, correct spelling of names will be provided no later than 10 weeks prior to the event so the order can be placed.
- Team members will be given 2 shirts free of charge (supplied by Archery ACT Society Inc). Additional shirts will be the responsibility of the archer.
- Provided there are no changes to the team shirt, team members who already possess a team shirt can request a monetary amount, equivalent to the two shirts, to go towards their registration in the event.
- Archers competing at the national events who are not part of the team may elect to purchase a shirt of opposing colours to be worn at the event.

## **Parents/Carers**

- Where a team member is accompanied by parent(s)/guardian(s) to a Championships, those parent(s)/guardian(s) shall acknowledge that the Team Member’s behaviour, participation and matters relating to shooting shall be vested in the Team Manager and Assistant Manager
- An ACT team application form (Appendix 2) and media consent form (Appendix 4) shall be completed and signed by parent(s)/guardian(s) and archers and submitted to the Team Manager prior to the closing date for entries.

- All minors (under 18 years of age) participating as a member of the AACT team must be accompanied by an adult, approved by the parents/guardians, with contact details and information provided to the team manager.

### **Team manager**

- The team manager and assistant Manager will be elected at a meeting of AACT two months prior to the start of the National Championships.
- Team managers and assistant managers must express an interest by nominating with relevant forms (Appendix 3)
- The team manager and assistant manager will be reimbursed an amount equivalent to the entry fee for the target event, to accommodate travel costs
- Two state team uniform shirts shall be provided in the first year of selection and in any subsequent year if required
  - Shirts will include the title of Team Manager, and Assistant Manager as required
- The team manager shall be provided a petty cash advance as determined from time to time to cover incidental expenses, which will require acquittal upon completion of the event.
- Must have a current WWVP card and have the number and expiration date lodged with AACT

### **Duties:**

The Team Manager shall:


- Attend to the wellbeing and morale of all archers in the team
- Attend team managers meetings as necessary and keep all team members advised of all relevant information
- On behalf of the team members and, if required, make representations to the tournament committee and/or jury of appeal
- Be responsible for the administration and management of the team and the welfare of all team members at training and competition
- Prepare and submit a report on the performance of the team at a meeting of AACT as soon as practicable thereafter no later than two (2) meetings of the RGB after the close of the National Championships
- Keep an accurate record of funds and prepare a financial report at the conclusion of the championship for the AACT Committee




