

End of Year Awards Function Guidelines

Archery ACT will hold an end of year function hosted in cyclical nature by each of the clubs, Canberra Archery Club (CAC), Weston Valley Archery Club (WVAC), and Tuggeranong Archery Club (TAC). The clubs will be responsible for organising a venue and communicating with the ACT committee and its members. A schedule will be available to club committees on a 6-year projection. The purpose for this event is to provide an atmosphere and environment that promotes an inclusive archery community.

This event will allow for opportunities to:

- Present ACT perpetual trophies
- Acknowledge Australian Representation from members
- Acknowledge Youth, Indoor and Open National ACT teams,
- Possible guest speaker
- Recognise outstanding performances throughout the year
- Allowing opportunities for clubs to present Club level awards if requested

Archery ACT will provide up to 4 tickets for the organising committee of this event to support the hosting club. Names of the committee to be submitted to the ACT committee prior to the event.

Perpetual trophies to be awarded:

1. Most improved archer

This trophy is intended to be awarded to the “most improved archer”, regardless of discipline, having demonstrated the most growth in their individual rating over the year.

The rating is tracked from the months 1st January to 31st October.

Archers must have competed in not less than 5 events above club level.

2. Overall Championship Winner

5 awards: Open recurve, Open compound, Youth, Senior (masters and veterans) and Longbow/Barebow


Points will be awarded according to overall placing, regardless of gender (1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points, 5th = 1 point). To be eligible for this award archers must compete in a minimum of 3 ACT events from the Target, Field, Clout and Indoor).

Only Archers who are members of Archery ACT will be eligible for this award.

In the event of a tie. Overall scores will be taken into consideration.

3. Volunteer of the Year

Clubs to nominate volunteers, with a brief outline of details of their actions using nomination form, by 31st October. The Archery ACT committee will make a decision on the winner from those nominated.
