



Pedicab Rules in Central Park

General Rules

All pedicabs must follow the Rules of the City of New York Section 1-02 Title 56 and shall operate in compliance with the New York Administrative Code (§ 20-259, §20-255, and §20-249)

- Pedicabs are only allowed on the Drives and may not be operated or stopped in the recreation or bike lanes, including bike lanes on 72nd St. cross drive.
- All pedicabs must remain in the far right lane, except when passing.
- Pedicabs may not ride adjacent to another pedicab, bicycle or vehicle except when using the left lane to pass.
- No pedicabs on the bridle path, pathways or playgrounds.
- Pedicabs must ride in the direction of traffic and obey all rules of the road.
- Pedicabs must yield the right of way to pedestrians, skaters and horse drawn carriages.
- No pedicabs shall occupy an area reserved for buses, taxicabs, horse drawn carriages or other vehicles.
- No commercial advertising on the pedicab unless the Drives are open to vehicular traffic.
- All pedicab drivers and pedicabs must be licensed.
- Drivers should not leave pedicabs unattended.
- In exceptional circumstances, such as large-scale special events and athletic competitions, pedicabs can be prohibited from operating.
