EXHIBITOR & EQUINE AGES AS OF 1/1/2020

Pleasure Ring Divisions

- **Halter**-Exhibitor/Equine may show in as many halter classes as their equine qualifies for.
- **Leadline/Walk**-(8 & Under) Exhibitor/Equine combination to show in halter, leadline showmanship and leadline equitation/horsemanship and leadline gaming only. Attendant can walk attached or unattached to the equine. Should an exhibitor/equine move up into W/T or WTC divisions, they will forfeit all Leadline/Walk points accumulated at prior years' shows.
- **Walk/Trot 13 & Under**-Exhibitor/Equine combination to show exclusively in the walk/trot 13 and under showmanship and performance classes. Exhibitor/Equine combination may not ride in other division's classes however can show in multiple halter classes, Sweepstakes Halter, Sweepstakes Showmanship, Sweepstakes W/T, Open W/T classes and In Hand Trail. Horse/Pony may be shown in another division with another exhibitor. Exhibitor may also show another equine in another division. Should an exhibitor/equine move up into the WTC divisions, they will forfeit all W/T points accumulated.
- **Walk/Trot 14 & Over**-Exhibitor/Equine combination to show exclusively in the walk/trot 14 and over showmanship and performance classes. Exhibitor/Equine combination may not ride in other division's classes however can show in multiple halter classes, Sweepstakes Halter, Sweepstakes Showmanship, Sweepstakes W/T, Open W/T classes and In Hand Trail. Horse/Pony may be shown in another division with another exhibitor. Exhibitor may also show another equine in another division. Should an exhibitor/equine move up into the WTC divisions, they will forfeit all W/T points accumulated.
- **Age Divisions (13 & Under)(14-18)(19 & Over)**-Exhibitor/Equine combination to show exclusively in their respective age division's showmanship and performance classes. Exhibitor/Equine combination may not ride in other divisions classes, however can show in multiple halter classes, sweepstakes, jumping and open classes. Horse/Pony may be shown in another division with another exhibitor. Exhibitor may also show another equine in another division.
- **Open Division**-Open to any age exhibitor/equine combination. Leadline/Walk exhibitor/equine combinations may not enter.
- **Jumping Division**-Open to any age exhibitor/equine combination. Leadline/Walk and Walk/Trot exhibitor/equine combinations may not enter jumping division classes. Exhibitors MUST wear ASTM helmets.
- **Open Fun Class**-Open to any age exhibitor/equine combination. Anyone can show in this class regardless of the division they are showing in for the day. If you are showing in W/T/C classes and this is a W/T event, you CAN show in it! **This is soely for FUN!** This class does not accumulate points for Year End Awards.

Gaming Ring Divisions

- **Leadline/Walk**-(8 & Under) Exhibitor/Equine combination to show in halter, leadline showmanship and leadline equitation/horsemanship and leadline gaming only. Attendant can walk attached or unattached to the equine. Should an exhibitor/equine move up into W/T or WTC divisions, they will forfeit all Leadline/Walk points accumulated at prior years' shows.
- **Walk/Trot**-Exhibitor/Equine combination to show exclusively in the walk/trot gaming classes. Exhibitor/Equine combination may not ride in other division's classes Horse/Pony may be shown in another division with another exhibitor. Exhibitor may also show another equine in another division. Should an exhibitor/equine move up into the WTC divisions, they will forfeit all W/T points accumulated.
- **Pony Divisions (13 & Under)(14 & Over)**-Exhibitor/Equine combination to show exclusively in their respective pony age division. Pony may be shown in another division with another exhibitor. Exhibitor may also show another equine in another division. Exhibitor/Equine may show in their respective division in the pleasure arena, however it can not be a leadline or walk/trot division.
- **Age Divisions (HORSE ONLY) (13 & Under)(14-18)(19 & Over)**-Exhibitor/Equine combination to show exclusively in their respective age division's showmanship and performance classes. Exhibitor/Equine combination may not ride in other divisions classes, however can show in multiple halter classes, sweepstakes, jumping and open classes. Horse may be shown in another division with another exhibitor. Exhibitor may also show another equine in another division.

Show Grounds Rules

- **Classes**-A one minute call will be enforced, if you require a tack change, please notify the office or ring steward prior to the start of the classes. The show chairman may combine or split classes as necessary. Proper attire, foot wear and tack must be worn for each respective discipline, including gaming.
- **Placings**-Awards will be provided for 1st-6th place with the exception of the Sweepstakes classes, where payback is provided.
- **Sweepstakes**-Payback will be 60% and will be given for the top 4 placings. Minimum of 4 entries for a payback, otherwise the class will place to 6 and you can collect the placing award. These classes are open to any age exhibitor/equine and do not accumulate points towards year end high point.
- **Jackpot**-One Sweepstakes class per arena, per show will have a \$50 added jackpot. Placings 1st-4th will receive the standard 60% sweepstakes payout as well as a portion of the \$50 added jackpot. There is a minimum of 6 entries required for the added Jackpot, otherwise the class will run as a normal Sweepstakes Class with 4+ entries or a regular class with less than 4 entries.
- **Camping**- Is permitted on the grounds during shows. Anyone under 18 camping must be accompanied by an adult. Reservations are required for overnight camping. Sites are subject to availability. Sites with electric and water connection are \$20/day or \$35/weekend. Primitive camping is \$15/day. Seasonal camping available to Members ONLY with a signed contract and \$175 seasonal fee. If you arrive on Friday, the day fee applies.

Year End High Point

- **Eligibility Requirements:** A current year paid membership, in Good Standing and have fulfilled required volunteer time. Show at a minimum of 4 shows, with the same equine, in the same division to accumulate points. Points begin accumulating AFTER your membership is paid. You may not change divisions during the season (Ex: Go from w/t to wtc, etc.) Sweepstakes classes do not accumulate points towards year end awards. Judge's Feedback show does not count towards the 4 shows or accumulate points for year end.
