Frankenmuth, MI

Sun., October 27th – Tues., October 29th , 2019

Day 1 – Sunday – Arrive at St. Christopher parking lot (147th and Karlov) at **7:15am**(arrival), prepare for a **8:00am departure** time. (St. Christopher Parish offers a 7:30am Sunday Mass if you're interested) Travel through Indiana with a continental breakfast on the bus. (goodies and snack sharing always welcome!) Continue traveling through the fall colors of Michigan. Our lunch stop is near the Lansing, MI area. Included in our day of traveling toward Frankenmuth is our "Spirit of Halloween Adventures". We have some great Halloween traditions on this day that can also be an option for our travelers who especially enjoy trains and ghosts. We'll tell you more on the bus ride. In Frankenmuth our accommodations for the next two nights are at "*Zehnder's of Frankenmuth Bavarian Haus*" featuring Splash Village, overlooking "*Bronner's the World's Largest Christmas Wonderland*". Dinner will be at *Zehnder's* with their famous all you can eat chicken dinner. Afterwards you can get a glimpse of their famous Bavarian bakery.
