OPERATIONAL POLICY

TITLE Personal Medical Kits

POLICY NO: 2013-012

POLICY STATEMENT:

Superior EMS is committed to providing staff with the appropriate medical supplies to provide comprehensive medical care both on and off-duty. It is expected that superior EMS staff will ensure their personal kit is fully stocked and in good order to provide immediate medical attention as needed.

POLICY OBJECTIVE:

The purpose of this policy is to establish standards for personal medical kits.

SCOPE:

All Staff and Volunteers of Superior EMS

POLICY:

Superior EMS staff and volunteers will be provided with a personal medical kit upon request. This kit can be used both on and off-duty as appropriate.

Personal medical kits remain property of superior EMS and must be returned upon termination of employment, resignation, or upon demand from management.

Personal medical kits must be maintained in good order, and must meet the minimum stock requirements listed below. Staff may also add additional approved items as they see fit.
