TITLE	Notification of Duty Officer / Management
POLICY NO:	2015-053

POLICY STATEMENT:

To ensure that the duty officer or management is notified by the crew or communications staff of every/all situations that may compromise resources needed to render the full scope of Superior EMS services

SCOPE:

All Employees, volunteers

POLICY:

The **duty officer** shall be notified of every/all situations that has, or may compromise any of the resources needed to render the full scope of our services. This includes:

- 1. When staffing is inadequate for the event
- 2. When there is an incident involving a Superior EMS staff or volunteers (including but not limited to injury)
- 3. Where there is an incident requiring multiple EMS vehicles (multiple casualty incidents)
- 4. Where there is a CBRNE incident
- 5. When there is an evacuation of the event site, bomb threat, hostage situation, armed standoff, etc.
- 6. Where there is critical equipment and/or vehicle failure
- 7. When there is an incident involving Superior EMS vehicles (including but not limited to vehicle breakdown or accident)
- 8. Whenever there are concerns that could have a negative impact on the operations of Superior EMS

Notification of the management team should occur:

- 1. When the crew cannot communicate with the duty officer
- 2. The duty officer will notify the management team when the following occurs:
 - a. Major injury to staff/volunteers
 - b. CBRNE incidents
 - c. Evacuations, bomb threats, hostage situations, armed stand-offs
 - d. Other issues as needed or appropriate
