SUMMARY:

The commander of auxiliary and communications is responsible for the oversight, coordination, and ongoing training of auxiliary members to support EMS and Fire/Rescue Operations, and to oversee, coordinate and monitor communications programs within the operations division.

- Assists management team as required in recruitment of staff
- Oversees communications policies and procedures
- Trains and recruits dispatchers, and ensures dispatch services are available on scheduled events
- Maintains and coordinates communication equipment
