2018 CME REQUIREMENTS SUPERIOR EMS

Superior EMS is committed to the quality of our service delivery. One of the methods for ensuring this quality is to ensure that all staff maintain and enhance their knowledge, skills and to learn about different clinical situations that occur less often in the field. To ensure we meet the highest standards, we have established our 2018 continuing medical education (CME) standards.

Our goal is to provide all staff with an opportunity to self-direct their CME needs as much as possible, as well as to ensure specific skills are monitored in a controlled learning environment. Our 2018 CME program will ensure there are a variety of options to acquire all the required CME by the deadlines. We encourage all staff to engage in as many CME activities as possible to support continued growth and improvement of skills.

We appreciate that many of our staff are employed with other services, and we want to ensure that there is not a duplication of services. As such, we do accept skills sign-offs from other services to ensure there is no need for duplication. Also, reminder that there are automatic exemption credits for those employed with other services.

To ensure the high-quality standards of our staff and volunteers, please ensure you pay particular attention to the CME reporting timelines to ensure that your position remains active and not moved to an administrative suspension status for non-completion.

2018 CME Requirements

- (1) Attend a minimum of 1 Skills Training Session by the end of the calendar year.
- (2) Maintain skills sign-off logs of all required annual skills by way of attendance at staff training, or through other approved sources (i.e. current paramedic employer).
- (3) Complete a minimum of 6 Classroom Credits as approved in our CME program, and Complete a minimum of 2 self-learning activities.
- (4) Complete all required re-certifications as required in your individualized learning plan.

2018 CME Deadlines

April 30, 2018 – Completion of 2 Classroom Credits and 1 Self-Learning Activities **November 30, 2018** – completion of the additional 4 Classroom Credits and 1 Self Learning Activities, as well as the 1 Skills Training Session.
