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Basic Emergency Care of an Injured Eye

- Flushing only for chemical injury and if eye is not perforated
- No salves or medicines
- Do not remove blood clots
- Don't force eye open unless flushing
- Do not let patient walk without help
- Patch both eyes
- Do not allow patient to eat or drink
- Don't panic
- Have patient see doctor

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Extruded or Impaled Eyeball

- With an extruded eyeball or an impaled object in the eye you should cover both eyes but do not apply pressure.
- 2) With an extruded eyeball, do not try to replace it, cover it with moist dressings
- 3) With an impaled object, do not attempt removal of FB. Keep patient still and keep talking to or touching the patient so they know you are there.
