**Gail Fowler, MA**, Violence Intervention Program Manager, has worked for Safeplace for over 14 years. Additionally Gail has been a trainer on the subject of domestic violence for over 8 years. Having worked extensively in court advocacy and with court ordered batterers, Gail has personally conducted over 3200 PEACE assessments of batterers over the past 12 years. She currently attends five PEACE groups that meet weekly and is a co-facilitator of two of the groups. Gail obtained her B.S. Law Enforcement from the University of North Alabama and Master of Science in Criminal Justice from Faulkner University. Gail participated in “ride alongs” with the Florence Police Department for over four years and logged over 900 hours with officers. The ride-along experience gave Gail the opportunity to speak with victims on the scene of a domestic crime, observe behaviors of perpetrators on the scene, and observe police officers on the scene.
