PERMIT CONDITIONS

In accordance with the provisions of Ordinance Number 16, Section 5, of the Lincoln County Code of Ordinances, and the Rules of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Chapter 391-3-7, Erosion and Sedimentation Control, both as amended, this Permit is issued for the land disturbing activity recorded hereon and presented on the attached Approved Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan.

This Permit is subject to revocation on a finding of noncompliance with any of the provisions of Ordinance Number 16, Section 5 of the Lincoln County Code of Ordinances, as amended, or the Rules promulgated pursuant thereto, or with any representation made in the application or the statements and supporting data entered therein and attached hereto.

This Permit is effective until completion of the aforementioned land disturbing activity. However, if the land disturbing activity does not commence within twelve (12) months from the date issued, this Permit will become null and void.

Unless otherwise exempted, persons engaged in land-disturbing activities shall apply erosion and sediment control measures which conform to the specifications contained in the publication entitled "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia", published by the State Soil and Water Conservation Committee, or shall apply alternate design criteria which are equivalent and which conform to sound conservation and engineering practices.

Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Lincoln County and all officers, employees or agents of the County, or any political subdivision thereof, against any and all claims, damages, actions, causes of action, costs and expenses of whatsoever nature, which may result from any injury, death, loss or damage arises out of construction, operation, maintenance, repair, removal or relocation of the facilities covered by this Permit.

This Permit is further subject to and conditioned upon the general and/or special conditions attached to this Permit and any attached page(s), which are a part of the Permit.

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
