

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS DISPOSAL AFFIDAVIT

Under EPD rules and Lincoln County ordinance Construction and Demolition Debris may only be disposed of at a Permitted Solid Waste Facility. Asbestos containing materials must be disposed of at a permitted Solid Waste Facility (IE...Richmond County Landfill by permit 706-592-3200). All other construction and demolition debris must be disposed of in a permitted Construction and Demolition Landfill (IE...Sample and Son Inc. 706-541-1215) It is unlawful to burn or otherwise dispose of construction and demolition debris improperly.

Code of Lincoln County Sec. 58-162. Unlawful disposal of solid waste, refuse, garbage or rubbish.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to dump or bury or cause to be dumped or buried any garbage, refuse, solid waste, or rubbish anywhere in the unincorporated area of the county not previously approved by the county and/or the appropriate state authorities.
- (b) *Improper disposal prohibited.* The disposal of solid waste in any manner that will impair the air quality, impair the quality of ground or surface water, impair the quality of the environment or likely create other hazards to the public health, safety, or well being is prohibited.

Code of Lincoln County Sec. 58-164. Unlawful burning.

- (b) The burning of construction and demolition debris is prohibited, even if the property owner grants express permission.
- (c) The burning of solid waste is prohibited in any manner, even if the burning is done safely.

391-3-4-.01 Definitions. Amended.

(5) "**Asbestos-Containing Waste**" means any solid waste containing more than 1 percent, by weight, of naturally occurring hydrated mineral silicates separable into commercially used fibers, specifically the asbestiform varieties of serpentine, chrysotile, cummingtonite-grunerite, amosite, riebeckite, crocidolite, anthophyllite, tremolite, and actinolite, using the method specified in Appendix A, Subpart F, 40 CFR Part 763, Section 1

(14) "**Construction/Demolition Waste**" means waste building materials and rubble resulting from **construction**, remodeling, repair, and **demolition** operations on pavements, houses, commercial buildings and other structures. Such waste include, but are not limited to asbestos containing waste, wood, bricks, metal, concrete, wall board, paper, cardboard, inert waste landfill material, and other non-putrescible wastes which have a low potential for groundwater contamination.

Under the 2006 Comprehensive Litter Prevention and Abatement Act Georgia Law provides for penalties of, up to \$25,000.00, prison term of up to five years or both for the unlawful disposal of Solid Waste. O.C.G.A. 16-7-53 (c) and (e) (1)
