Call Meeting to Order

Chairman Norman called the meeting to order.

Attorney Jackson gave the invocation.

Health Insurance Renewal

On a motion by Commissioner Cliatt, seconded by Commissioner Collins, the Board voted for the County to increase the amount they pay toward employee's health insurance to \$600 and the employee pay the balance of the option they choose. Commissioner Wade voted against the motion.


The Chairman informed the Board that the health insurance has gone up 16% from last year which mandates an increase in the amount the County must pay from \$500 to a minimum of \$580. Director Bussey presented the Board with a summary history of the insurance costs since 2009 which included several options of the amount the County can pay and the amount left for the employee to pay.

Commissioner Wade made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cliatt, to pay the minimum of \$580 with the employee paying the balance. After much discussion, Commissioner Cliatt withdrew his second and the motion failed due to lack of a second.
