**All entries must be decorated to be entered into the 2021
Christmas Parade**

There will be judging of ALL FLOATS with 1st and 2nd places... CASH PRIZES will be awarded. All other Christmas parade entrants will receive one ticket per parade entry, to be entered into a raffle. The raffle will be drawn at 1 p.m. and the winners immediately will be notified, and prizes will be given.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All Christmas parade entrants must READ and SIGN the Rules and Regulations section of the Christmas Parade Registration Form. Christmas parade check in will begin at 12 noon on Lillian Sims Drive, located in front Of the Buddy Bufford Football field. All entrants must be lined up by 12:45 p.m. or you will not be allowed to participate.

1. Christmas Parade Registration forms must be submitted prior to the event. Deadline is Wednesday, November 24, 2021, at 5 p. m. Christmas Parade coordinators and Sponsor of the Christmas parade, Directors staff and appointed Volunteers reserve the right to approve or disapprove a float or Christmas parade entry on site.
2. Rain or shine the Christmas parade must go on, so please plan accordingly.
3. All entrants must follow instructions and map for line-up times and location.
4. The order of the Christmas parade line up is determined by the Christmas parade coordinators. Special requests cannot and will not be accommodated.
5. No personal vehicles will be allowed to enter Lillian Sims Drive during the Christmas parade line up, which begins at 12:45 p.m. Courtesy will be provided to residents on Lillian Sims Drive.
6. The Sponsor of the Christmas parade reserves the right to have the ONLY SANTA in the Christmas parade. Stuffed Santa's are permissible as decorations

7. Four wheelers are allowed only when used in pulling a float or affiliated with an organization like that of the Shriners. Motorcycles will be allowed to ride in the Christmas parade if part of a club. Motorcyclists WILL NOT be allowed to excel in speed during Christmas parade route, nor high throttle engines. Those who disobey will be removed from the Christmas parade by law enforcement and penalized with a fine of up to \$1000 and/or imprisonment.
8. Modern cars or trucks will be allowed in the Christmas parade only if they from part of an organized car club, pulling an approved decorated float / entry; or is an approved vehicle / convertible and the passenger is a Pageant winner.
9. Classic cars, convertibles and preapproved vehicles are acceptable. Identity signage is required and must be neatly prepared. Magnetic car signs are preferred.
10. All pageant winners are encouraged to prepare ahead of time and enter floats.
11. **All golf carts / utility entries MUST be decorated, or they will not be allowed to ride in the Christmas parade.**
12. Notice to Equine Participants: **Warning**, Under Georgia Law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities. pursuant to Chapter 12 Of Title 4 of the official code of Georgia annotated (O.C.G.A. 4-12-(3a). Negative Coggins required. Participants must arrange for animal waste to be remove during the Christmas parade.
13. If you intend to fly the US Flag, please observe proper flag etiquette: (<https://wvmv.va.gov/opa/publications/celebrate/flagdisplay.pdf>). Service flags should be carried in the order the service was established:
 - a. Army
 - b. Marine Corps Flag
 - c. Navy Flag
 - d. Air Force Flag
 - e. Coast Guard Flag
 - f. Space Flag
14. **NO Confederate or battle flags, no political group flags**
15. All signs are to be legible, bold, neat, and appropriate for the event. Spectators, photography cameras and video cameras cannot detect handwritten signs. Entrants may be asked to remove inappropriate signs by Christmas Parade Coordinators.
16. **Spacing between entries in the Christmas parade needs to maintain at least 30 feet for safety. Make sure there is adequate spacing between participants. Every participant or group will STOP at the Stop Sign at end of Main Street and pause for 30 seconds, pull up in front of the announcer so they may introduce your entry "commentary" for the videography person.**
17. Children must be **ALWAYS** accompanied by a parent or an adult during the Christmas parade from line-up prior to, during and at disassembly. Parents are asked to pick up their child(ren) immediately following the Christmas parade on Lillian Sims Drive.

- 18. The Christmas Parade Sponsor, City Police and Lincoln County Law Enforcement reserve the right to ask any disruptive or inappropriate entrant to be dismissed from the Holidays In Olde Lincolnton Christmas Parade proceedings.
- 19. No person operating any vehicle may consume any alcohol before or during the Christmas parade. Drivers Of all vehicles must possess a valid driver's license.
- 20. Due to COVID restrictions the following rules apply:
 - a. All foot entrants must maintain 6 feet distance from one another.
- 21. Please do not litter. Please use the trash cans along the route, and responsibly dispose of your trash.
- 22. **ALL CANDY MUST BE PRE-BAGGED BEFORE THROWING INTO THE CROWD ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE**
