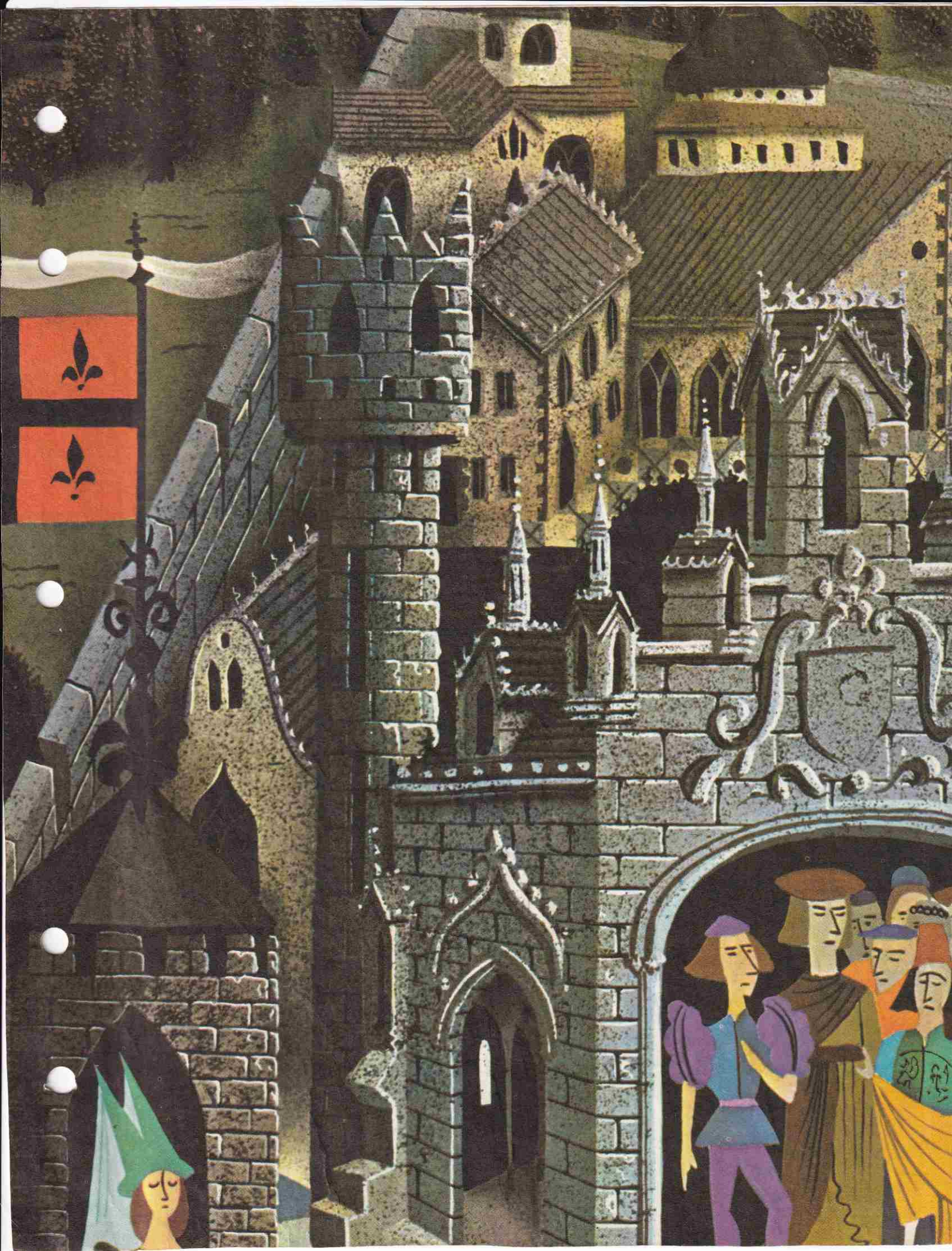

Were Afraid to Ask

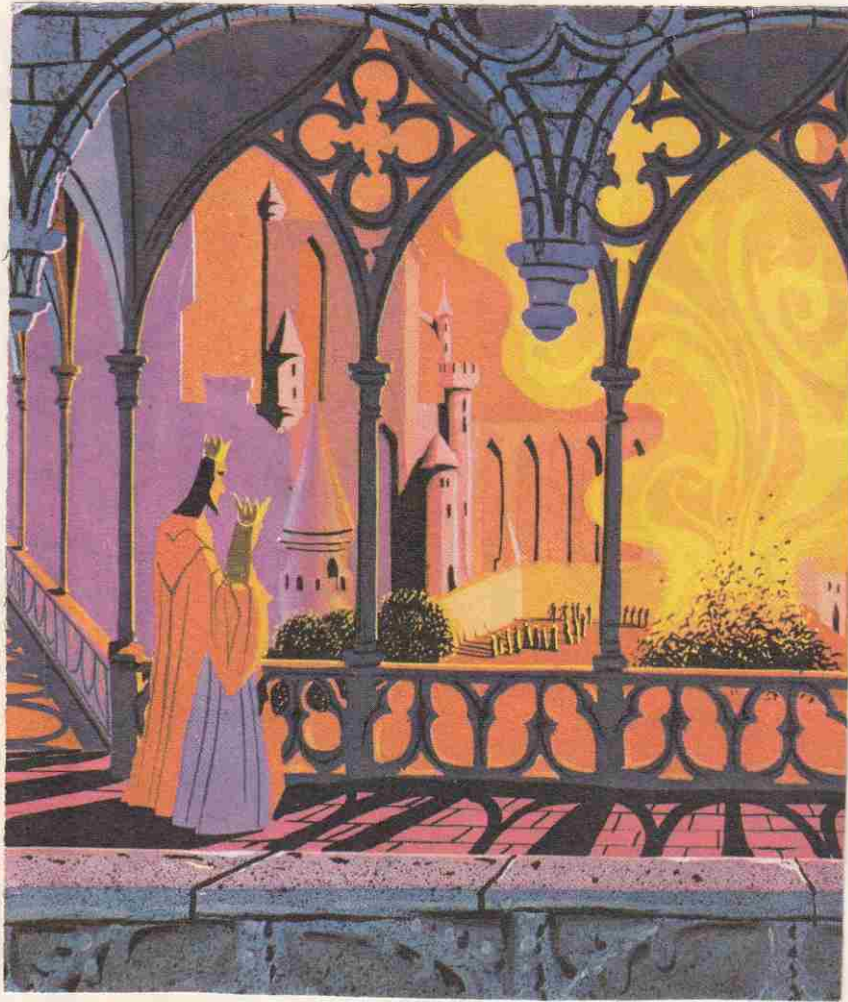

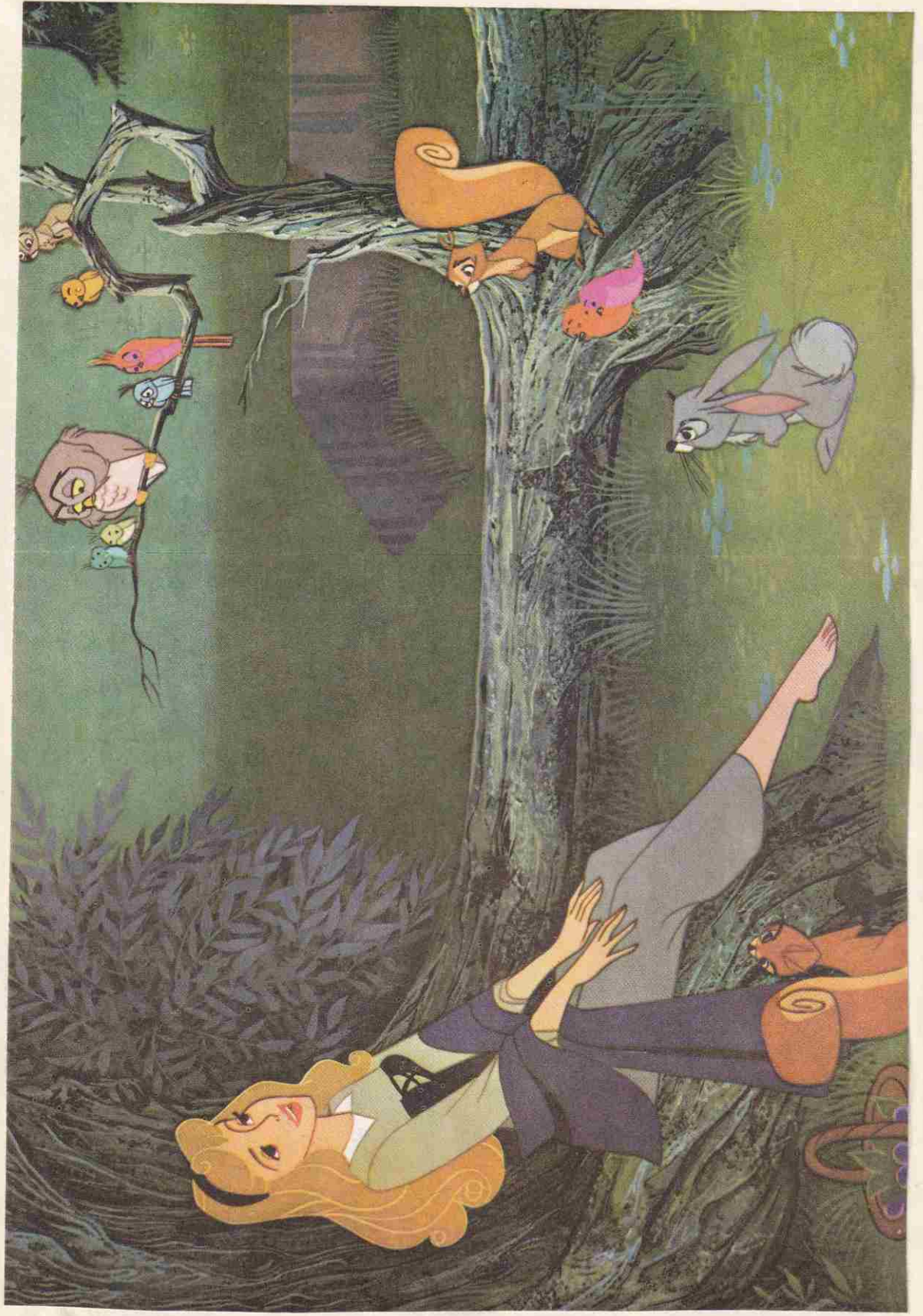
