# Our ICC Program & PUF Program

Hi I am Darlene and as an Educator at the Athabasca Multiplex Whispering Hills Day Care I understand how important it is to have tools and resources in order to give the children who attend the opportunities for early childhood development. My position at the daycare includes working with children who receive PUF, ICC support plus all the children that attend Daycare regularly. The inclusive policy that the Daycare goes by is a great benefit for all children attending the Daycare.

Our space was created for the children to go to for times when they need a quiet space to read and look at books, to talk with an educator about their emotions and we have other materials in the room that benefit and support the growth and development of, gross, fine, cognitive, problem solving, literacy healthy well being and social interactions. Working with children who have goals to work on their fine motor skills the Daycare was able to purchase materials (recommended by the Occupational Therapist and the G.R.I.T. Program) to support and develop these skills. Fine motor skills are critical for all children to develop in their early years. Educational toys and awesome games for gross motor development were also purchased. Gross motor skills for all children is as equally critical for children's' early development. I see the results and progress in the children I work with at the Daycare and the benefits from the additional toys, books, materials and resources. This couldn't be done without the funding from outside supports our ELCC Grants, PUF FUNDING & ICC FUNDING!

I am extremely grateful and happy for the Government funding to be able to offer such unique opportunities in our Daycare centre. The children that attend our Daycare have enormous opportunities to play with so many materials, resources, games, toys and books both for inside and outside play that supports and enhances their early childhood development.
