In recognition for his contributions as a musician and philanthropist, Nash was appointed an Officer of the Order of the British Empire (OBE) by Queen Elizabeth. Nash wrote many of CSN's hit singles, including Marrakesh Express, Our House, Teach Your Children, Just A Song Before I Go, and Wasted On The Way. While continually building his musical legacy, Nash is also an internationally renowned photographer and visual artist






Trent Severn
