**Festival information:**

The festival is looking for vendors relating to the pop culture and music of Johnny Cash and June Carter and relevance to country music.

Artists and vendors are only allowed to sell items listed on the application unless otherwise approved prior to the event days. While the Love in Bloom Festival supports direct sales of independent consultants, the festival does not allow those into the event (i.e. LulaRoe, Young Living, Mary Kay, etc). Festival organizers have the right to have artist vendors remove items from display that do not meet festival standards.

Vendors will be located at the corner of East Kentucky and Court Street, one block off the square in historic downtown Franklin KY. Artist vendors are located across street from the concert venue.

Access to the vendor area will be two (2) hours prior to gates opening (Saturday 8 am and Sunday 10 am). NO VEHICLES will be allowed in the venue area during the event.

Tear down may begin no sooner than 8 pm

Artist Vendor space is limited and includes an area of 10x10. Vendor **must** provide tent (white is preferred but not required), tent stakes are not permitted. Electric is not available.

Vendors are responsible for having proper trademark/copyright authority for their work.

In the case of festival/concert cancellation, vendor fees will be refunded.
