RIVERSIDE CAMPGROUND RULES

We hope that you will enjoy your stay at Riverside Campground. We work hard to keep this a clean, safe, fun and beautiful place for everyone. We ask for your help in doing this by abiding by the following rules.

CHECK-IN IS 2 PM. CHECK-OUT IS 11 AM: You may check in early if your site is available. Late check-out fee is \$5 which allows you to stay until 3 PM if your site is available.

SPEED LIMIT IS 5 MPH AND IS STRICTLY ENFORCED.

GOLF CARTS: You must register your golf cart at the office. There is a \$20 registration fee. Speed limit is 5 MPH and is strictly enforced. No golf carts should be driven after 9 PM. You must be at least 16 years old to drive a golf cart. Only one warning, second offence you must take your golf cart home.

BICYCLE RIDING: is not permitted after dark. ALL children must wear helmets at all times. Skateboards, motorbikes, and battery-powered vehicles are not permitted. Motorcycles are permitted to and from your campsite only.

PETS: are not allowed in any buildings, pool area or playground areas. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times and not left unattended. They must not make excessive noise and must be cleaned up after. No large, aggressive dogs are permitted such as but not limited to, Pit-Bulls, Rottweilers, Dobermans, and German Shepherds.

CHILDREN: Parents are responsible for the behavior of and the actions of their children. Make sure they know the rules. There must always be a responsible adult over the age of 21 at the campsite. Please do not leave children unattended. All children and teenagers must be at their campsite by 11 PM. At the pool children under the age of 14 must be with an adult. All babies not potty trained must wear "little swimmers" in the pool. Swim at your own risk. NO lifeguard is on duty.

ALL VISITORS MUST REGISTER AT THE OFFICE: Visitors must leave by the time the gate gets locked at night (11 PM). \$2 for each visitors pass plus \$3 swimming pass. \$5 for each overnight visitor plus \$3 swimming pass. The registered camper is responsible for the behavior of their quest and for ensuring that they comply with all campground rules.

PLEASE PLACE YOUR TRASH IN THE DUMPSTER and not in your fire ring. No mattresses, TVs, boxes or large rugs are to be place in the dumpster. Please take these items home with you. ONE (1) PICNIC TABLE PER SITE: Do not move tables from another site without checking with the

FIRES ARE ALLOWED ONLY IN THE FIRE RINGS PLACED IN DESIGNATED LOCATIONS: Do not move fire rings. Please use caution. Fires must be kept under control and not left unattended.

NO WASHING CARS, trailers or RVs on the property without permission from the office.

FIREARMS AND FIREWORKS, for the safety of others are not permitted in the campground.

FISHING LICENSE is required per Virginia State Law.

GREY WATER should not be dumped on the ground per Virginia State Law.

NO SMOKING is permitted in any campground buildings or the pool area. Please do not throw your butts on the ground. Please place in fire rings.

ILLEGAL DRUGS AND/OR PUBLIC DISPLAY OF INTOXICATION: will not be tolerated. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed discreetly at your campsite.

NO GLASS BOTTLES on river sites or at the pool.

TWO VEHICLES PER SITE: Extra vehicles must park in overflow parking not on other sites.

TO ACCESS THE RIVER please use steps provided. DO NOT trespass through other campers' site! NO SUBLETTING: If you are selling your camper on site, new tenant must be approved by the campground owner.

ALL DECKS must be approved by the office before being built. No refrigerators, freezers or house furniture on decks. Please pick up all toys and outside furniture so our grounds keepers can mow. Seasonal campers are responsible for their own weed eating. Please keep your site neat. If we feel that it needs maintenance you will be billed for it.

CLOTHESLINES are not permitted, you may however place a clothes rack on your deck.

WE DO NOT HOLD CHECKS OR ACCEPT POSTDATED CHECKS.

OUR SEASON runs April 1st through October 31st. The electric and water will be shut off on November 1st. NO ONE is permitted to stay through the winter.

MANAGEMENT reserves the right to evict campers in the event of unlawful activity, disobedience of rules, and destruction of grounds or display of unsuitable behavior. In the event of eviction, you have seven (7) days to remove your camper. During this time you are not permitted to stay in your camper or use any campground amenities. You are only allowed in the campground to remove your camper.
