Cavalier County Public Health will be holding **Influenza** (Flu) Vaccination Clinics for Langdon Schools on the following date:

# October 9

Langdon Area Elementary School – 8:30 am to 10:30 am.

Langdon Area Middle and High School – 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm

Cavalier County Public Health is committed to making vaccinations more **convenient** for parents and increasing the number of children vaccinated against influenza in our community. Flu vaccination is the <u>single best way</u> to help **prevent** your child from **getting** and **spreading** the flu. If you would like your child to receive seasonal influenza vaccination in school this fall to reduce the number of sick days affecting your family, please follow the steps below:

#### STEP 1. Consent Form

(additional Consent Forms can be downloaded at www.cavaliercountyhealth.com)

- Fill in ALL HIGHLIGHTED areas on the front and back of the Influenza Vaccine Consent Form.
- → The Consent Form must be completed in ink and signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- → Please return Consent Forms to the school office by October 7.

### STEP 2. Payment

- → Use the chart below to determine if payment applies to you.
- → Payment by cash or check is accepted. Checks should be made payable to **CCHD**. Payment may be sent with consent forms.

Most all insurance plans cover flu vaccine. \*You can call the number on the back of your insurance card to determine if your insurance policy covers the cost of seasonal flu vaccine.

# Are parents required to be present at the clinics?

Parents are not required to be present, but can be present if they so choose.

# Who can participate in the influenza clinics at my child's school?

All students in grades K-12 attending the school where the clinic is scheduled are eligible to participate.

# What if I change my mind and don't want my child to be vaccinated?

If, at <u>any time</u>, you change your mind about having your child vaccinated, you can withdraw your consent by calling the Cavalier County Health District office at 256-2402.

For parents preferring to be present when their child is vaccinated please note this on the permission form.

### What are contraindications?

A contraindication to flu vaccine means a person has a health condition which makes it inadvisable to give the vaccine. Please see the enclosed information for a complete list of contraindications.
