

Tim Podesta

Australian choreographer Tim Podesta graduated from The Australian Ballet School in 1997, going on to dance internationally as a soloist in works by leading choreographers and directors who inspired him to start creating his own work.

In 2017/18 works by Tim Podesta were performed in Australia, London, Wales, New York, Africa and Dubai for film, television and stage, including the much acclaimed *Shadow Aspect* making its London premiere in 2017 and winning 'Best Dance Production' at the Wales Theatre Awards.

Tim Podesta's film production ADOR, featuring dancers from The Singapore Dance Theatre, Hong Kong Ballet, Australian Dance Theatre, Atlanta Ballet, The Queensland Ballet, The English National Ballet and The Royal Ballet premiered to much acclaim and was where he met his creative partner, Principal dancer of the Royal Ballet Company Mara Galeazzi. Mara and Tim now direct the dance company M&T+ Projection Dance.

Currently Podesta is working on a new film starring Galeazzi and international star dancer Marlon Dino, a new season titled FORTE currently touring Australia and a new collaboration with Japanese designer Yukiko Tsukamoto to premiere at London's Sadler's Wells in December 2018.
