

God is Faithful

Continuing a mission of giving that began in 1922, our Presbyterian Women USA will sponsor this year's Birthday Offering on Mother's Day, May 12, 2019. The name "Birthday Offering" comes from the story of Hallie Paxson Winsborough challenging her Presbyterian Women's group to give one penny for each year of their lives as a birthday gift to a school for girls in Kochi, Japan.

Since that time, the Birthday Offering has become an annual tradition. Monetary gifts have funded nearly 100 manor mission projects to assist women and children both here in the USA and around the world. Birthday Offering grants primarily fund capital improvement projects. Because these are large projects, only a small number are chosen each year.

In 2019, we will offer our prayers and financial support for the following:

Disaster Response Team – Presbytery of Charlotte, Charlotte, North Carolina. This grant will help to expand their ministry to support people affected by human-made or natural disasters. PW's grant will help provide a warehouse, parking lot and security fencing. This new space will hold household goods, food, hygiene, and school kits, and clean-up buckets, and will house mobile shower units and disaster recovery trailers.

Effingham Child Development Center. This grant will be used to upgrade an inclusive playground in Effingham, Illinois serving children and families of differing abilities.. This project will literally pave the way for all kids to learn and play together. Funds will help to improve the playground by providing a protective play surface and all-inclusive play equipment.

Presbyterian Homes and Services of Kentucky, Inc. Good Shepherd Community Nursing Center, Phelps, Kentucky. This organization cares for people who are sick, poor, lonely, or vulnerable due to age and/or poor health. This grant will provide new wardrobes, bedside cabinets, beds,

mattresses, and other hospital equipment, improving the quality of life and safety for nursing home residents in the Appalachian region of Kentucky.

Winds of Refuge, Restoration Home, Iowa Falls, Iowa. This program provides a safe and healing space for women victimized by human trafficking. This grant will help fund a larger, long-term safe home for more women; providing restoration, identity, community, opportunity, hope, and transition to independent living.



A Fresh Look at the Ten Commandments

Words! Words! Words! We are accustomed to speaking of Jesus as the Word, or the Bible itself as God's Word, but we may never have thought of the Ten Commandments in that way. I've chosen to retain the term *Ten Words* because it is the biblical form and can help open us up to looking at the Ten Commandments in fresh ways.

Each lesson begins with an exploration of the Ten Words in their biblical contexts. From there, we consider a moment from Jesus' life that shows us how he lived out those Words. We then consider the Words for our own lives and contexts. We conclude with an invitation to pray with the Words in our circles or study groups and in our personal devotions.


How do we live out our relationship with God and with one another in a world that is often ruled by other standards? What is the pain from which God seeks to protect us in the Ten Words? How can a fresh embrace of these Words contribute to the restoration of ourselves, our communities, and the furthering of the gospel in the world?
