

A Message from Dan McNerney: Our mission partner and an associate director of Frontier Fellowship Dan just returned from 2 weeks in Egypt. In his letter, he says "The contrast between light and dark throughout the Arab world has never been

greater than it is now. ISIS, Al Qaeda, and the Brotherhood of Islam have done more to drive Egyptians and other Arabicspeaking people into the arms of our Lord, Jesus Christ, than any other factor in recent history. The utter darkness and cruelty of these movements have caused an increasing number of Egyptians to either become atheists, or be more moderate in their Islamic faith. or followers of a different religion, most notably Christianity. Egyptians want nothing more to do with radical Islam. They are seeking more light in their lives, and many are finding it in Christ." Pray that more and more Egyptians will seek Christ and that they will experience the healing and light Christ can bring to their lives.
