## **Information for Prospective Vendors**

Booth Registration Fee: Eliot Residents - \$35.00 until July 31;

\$45 from August 1st – August 31st

\$50 from September 1st – September 22nd

Non-Residents - \$60.00

\$70 from August 1st - August 31st

\$75 from September 1<sup>st</sup> – September 22<sup>nd</sup>

Farmers Market Fee: Eliot Residents - \$10.00 Non Residents: \$15.00

Non Profits **NOT** selling food, crafts, etc. to raise money (e.g. for information ONLY): \$15.00

Double fees are charged for 2 spaces, etc...

Arrival Time: Will be assigned by committee – Begins at 6:00am

\*\*No vehicle traffic between 8:00 - 8:40AM; Festival Hours: 9:00AM – 3:00PM (NO RAIN DATE)

Breakdown: 3:00 PM or later (NO REFUNDS)

#### **Booth Details:**

- Booth space is approximately 12 x 12 (location assigned by committee)

- Vendors supply their own tables and set-ups
- Only one organization or crafter per booth space
- Tent spikes are NOT ALLOWED for booths located on the pavement
- Electricity will NOT be available at the Elementary School or Hammond Park
- The use of generators is subject to committee approval at the time of registration
- No booth breakdowns prior to 3:00 PM
- Vendor is responsible for clean-up of booth and surrounding space
- The committee reserves the right to reject, on or before Aug 29<sup>th</sup>, ANY item considered unsuitable, inappropriate, objectionable, or not family appropriate
- The committee reserves the right to stop the sale and close the vendor's booth immediately if the vendor ignores the above stated clause
- The committee reserves the right to reject an application in the event it duplicates a previously accepted vendor's activity

#### **Application Deadlines:**

- Apply by July 31, 2018 to reserve your location space and to be listed in the program
- Applications will be accepted on a space available basis after July 31<sup>st</sup> until September 22<sup>nd</sup>, but will not be listed in the program **AND** there is an additional fee.
- A booth assignment map will be mailed to each vendor in early September. If your application is not accepted your check will be returned within 30 days.
