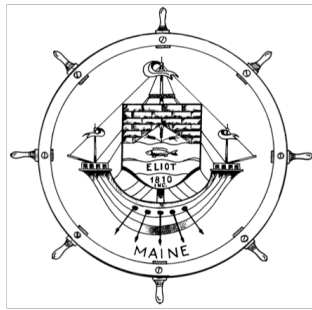

The 40th Annual Eliot Festival offers booth vendors, advertisers, and sponsors expanded visibility to a larger Festival in downtown Eliot on September 26th, 2020.

The booth fee includes your organization's listing in the Festival Days Brochure, the Festival website, and our Facebook and Instagram sites.

The Eliot Festival Days Brochure will be mailed to all households in Eliot prior to the Festival, increasing the reach of your organization's message.

Booth Rules and Regulations

Arrival Time begins at 6:00 am Sept. 26, 2020. Your time will be assigned by Booth Chair. **Parking entrance** is State Road at Eliot Elementary School. No vehicle traffic in Festival area between 8:00 am and 3:00 pm. Festival Hours are 9:00 am – 3:00 pm (NO RAIN DATE). Breakdown is 3:00 pm or later (NO REFUNDS).

Booth space is approximately 12 x 12 (location assigned by committee)

Booth Vendors supply their own tables and set-ups

Set-up crews are available to assist Vendors, just ask

Only one organization or crafter per booth space

Tent spikes are NOT ALLOWED for booths located on the pavement

Electricity is NOT available at the Elementary School or Hammond Park

The use of generators is subject to committee approval at the time of registration

No booth breakdowns prior to 3:00 pm

Booth Vendor is responsible for clean-up of booth and surrounding space

The committee reserves the right to reject, on or before Aug 25th, ANY item considered unsuitable, inappropriate, objectionable, or not family appropriate

The committee reserves the right to stop the sale and close the vendor's booth immediately if the vendor ignores the above stated clause

The committee reserves the right to reject an application in the event it duplicates a previously accepted vendor's activity. Earliest application date takes precedence

Application Deadlines

Apply by Aug. 1, 2020 to reserve your location space and to be listed in the Festival brochure.

Applications will be accepted on a space available basis after Aug. 1, 2020 but may not be listed in the Festival brochure.

The booth assignment map will be mailed to each vendor mid-September. If your application is not accepted your check will be returned within 30 days.
