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### Membership Privileges Include:

- 1 Use of track for open for practice - unless it is a race day, work day or the track is closed for special event. Track Hours are 8am to dusk.
- 2 Non-Members are only allowed to use the track for practice, when accompanied by a member.
- 3 Reduced entry fee for all club races.
- 4 Flyers / newsletters / e-mail announcing races, meetings, plans and other events.

### Membership Responsibilities

- 1 ALL MEMBERS and their CREW/FAMILY are required to read and be familiar with the KCKA RULES. We expect all members to be RESPONSIBLE enough to know them and abide by them at ALL TIMES.
- 2 Making sure that the track is in safe condition and that all people using the track are members and have the proper safety equipment.
- 3 Participation in at least one track work day. Work days will be announced at races and will usually occur on the 3rd Saturday of the Month.
- 4 All drivers are required to wear helmet, chest/rib protector, gloves, and protective jacket when operating any motorized vehicle on track.
- 5 Any member that will be driving on the track during an open practice session is required to sign in each time they visit the track.
- 6 Keeping the gate closed and locked at all times
- 7 To ensure sure that all members of their crew / family are signed in and are wearing wristbands. Failure to comply may result in forfeiture of raceday points

### Additional Information

- 1 The track is closed on the 3rd Friday and Saturday of each month (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- 2 By signing this waiver, you are releasing the KCKA and track owner from responsibility from any accidents that may occur.
- 3 Immediate family includes only those living in the same household.
- 4 All minor children (drivers & non-drivers) must sign a Minor Release Waiver/Parent consent form (one per year).
- 5 All memberships expire on December 31st of each year.
