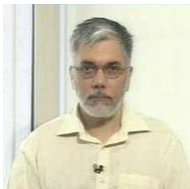
Rajiv Luthra, Founder & Managing Partner, Luthra & Luthra Law offices

The UIDAI has issued over a billion numbers to Indian residents. He was also responsible for the creation and launch of Google Map Maker - a crowd-sourced mapping product that is responsible for Google Maps data for 170+ countries (including India).
