Rules, Regulations, and Policies

A copy of all current CCNE Rules, Regulations, and Policies will be retained by the secretary and posted on the CCNE website.(Adopted: 3/14/12)

NEW MEMBERS

The CCNE membership application package will include a copy of the By-laws and Rules, Regulations, and Policies.(Adopted: 3/24/12)

Potential members applying for membership need to attend one (1) CCNE gathering/function attended by five (5) or more members. (Revised: 3/24/12 Wording Revised: 3/19/16)

New membership fees (\$205) include: An initiation fee of One Hundred dollars (\$100) plus the current first year's dues (\$70), and a burgee fee (\$35). (Adopted: 3/24/12)

In order for an application to be considered, it must be received by the Secretary, along with the required monies (initiation fee, first year's dues, and burgee fees,) and sponsor endorsements, a minimum one week in advance of asemi-annual Board of Governors' meeting. (Updated: 10/18/15)

Any member proposing new member(s) must be a CCNE member in good-standing for at least one fiscal year (4/1 - 3/31.)(Updated: 3/24/12)

MEMBERSHIP AND DUES

The members will be charged an annual membership fee of Seventy dollars (\$70.00.) CCNE membership dues are to be paid no later than March 1st. Dues paid between March 2nd and March 31st will incur a late fee of \$25.00. Any member, whose dues have not been paid by April 1st, will be dropped from the roster, and no longer be a member in good-standing. (Last Revised: 11/09/14)

The Associate Membership fee will be 50% of the Regular Membership fee. (1/28/17)

Burgees and replacement burgees are available to members in good-standing for a fee of Thirty-five dollars (\$35.00.) (Adopted: 3/24/12)

Members who are reinstated after resigning in good-standing shall not be required to pay anew initiation fee.(Adopted: 3/24/12)

In the event of any dissolution of relationships, at the time of the next dues cycle, each person is responsible for their own membership dues. (Adopted: 3/24/12)

ANNUAL CRUISE

The Fleet Captain has a budget of Thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per member boat.(Revised: 11/09/14)

Additional fees available to the Fleet Captain include:

- Guest boat (2 adults and all children under 12) Per member boat amount plus twenty dollars (\$20.00) (Revised: October 21, 2012)
 Guest boat will receive same "Cruise Memento" as member boats. (Adopted: October 21, 2012. Wording Revised 11.10.12, 11.09.14)
- Guests -- Ten dollars (\$10.00) each*

*Guest is defined as anyone not an immediate descendant.(Revised: March 24, 2012)

A boat may only attend one (1) cruise as a guest. (Adopted: March 24, 2012)
