

Bus Policy

Students, who use the school bus service, should consider the following terms and regulations:

- Be ready and wait on time in a position where the bus driver can see you before stopping the bus.
- Upon entering the bus, take a seat immediately, fasten seatbelts and remain seated while the bus is moving. Do not switch seats while travelling.
- Students must respect the wishes of the driver and bus chaperon at all times.
- Keep aisles clear of books, bags and other belongings.
- Eating and/or drinking on the bus is not permitted.
- Students should talk quietly using an 'inside' voice.
- Students must be courteous to fellow passengers
- Students should respect the property of the transport company.
- Students should arrive on time at the bus stop in the morning and go promptly to the bus at the end of the school day.
- Respect the driver and assistant.
- Should not open the window and dangle hands or head from the window of the bus.
- Avoid the actions and behaviors that might disturb the driver.
- Students should not tamper with or damage any of the fixtures or fittings on the bus.
- In the case of damaged bus property, a guardian will bear the costs of repairing the damage.

In order to create efficient and effective bus service, the following items are highly recommended to parents:

- Parents must inform the bus monitor if there are any changes to their child's transport arrangements.
- Parents must give updated telephone or mobile phone numbers to school and relevant Bus Monitor for contact in case of any emergency.
- Parents must ensure that students are at the pickup point at the designated time to ensure that students reach school on time.
- Ensure the students are out of the house on time, the bus will not wait more than 3 minutes.
- Parents must ensure that a responsible adult is present to send and collect primary children to and from the school bus in the morning and at the end of the day.
- In case there are any complaints and suggestions to enhance the bus service, please contact the school administration.
- The guardians are not allowed to get into the bus. In case of complaints, they should contact the school administration.
- In order to avoid traffic jam and narrow street traffic which may cause delay for the bus service, the students will set for a new "pick up" point which will be the nearest possible point of her/his house.

Regulations Agreement of the Bus Service

Dear Guardian,

In order to provide effective and comfortable bus service, encourage your children to follow the rules below:

- The student should sit in designated seat; he/she is not be allowed to change the seat during the trip.
- The student is not allowed to eat or drink on the bus.
- The student must avoid using any inappropriate words and comments on the bus driver.
- The student should not eat and drink on the bus.
- The student should keep his hands and legs to himself.
- The student should always keep the bus clean.
- The student should be quiet.
- The school has the right to stop its transportation service to any student who does not follow the regulations and instructions.
- The guardian needs to pay the price of damaged items caused by his/her student.
