

## The Clinic Policy

### **1. Purpose:**

The Emirates Falcon International Private School clinic is a health care facility within school intended to provide basic health care for students and /or refer them to the specialist/primary health center if required.

- To improve the delivery of quality healthcare services and protect students' health, rights and safety.
- To improve parents satisfaction.

### **2. Policy Statement:**

- It is the policy of Emirates Falcon International Private School Clinic is to serve all students without regard to race, age, sex, gender, identity, color, ancestry, nationality, economic status, religion, marital status, disability or handicap.

### **4. Target Audience:**

Students receiving treatment and services from Emirates Falcon International Private School Clinic.

### **5. Responsibility:**

It is the responsibility of Emirates Falcon International Private School Clinic and its entire staff to place student first and ensure the focus of care and services on high quality and best health care services. In this way we establish student's right and standards that will inform students what they may expect from us.

### **Administration of School Clinic**

School clinic will be administered in a manner to ensure high-quality health services while recognizing basic patient rights.

The primary roles undertaken by the School Clinic are as follows:

- Provide first aid or emergency care to sick or injured students.
- Assess students, to detect early signs and symptoms of health problems, which will affect learning.
- Monitor and maintain growth and development of students.
- Administer nursing care appropriate to the identified nursing needs of the students.
- Plan, implement and evaluate health education program for students.
- Plan, implement and evaluate vaccination program for all students in the School, under the supervision of SEHA.



### **Communications and Updates from the School Clinic:**

As and when it is appropriate, parents or guardians may receive the following notification from the School Nurse:

- Notification of Head Lice
- Notification of Communicable Diseases
- Vaccination information
- Other general illness or injury notifications
