We should be the 68th member of ADB in June and confirmed by December this year where membership fees will be \$100,000 one off payment.

Niue is a real hive of activity at present with Swanson, Tāoga, 4G, wharf repairs and strengthening new waste plant funded by Australia and other seemingly minor but equally important things such as UV treated water at the schools.
