

What God Has Joined Together



My Lord said, "What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder" (Mk. 10:8). Peter said, "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour" (1 Pt. 5:8). The devil is pulling out all stops to disrupt and ruin our lives, including our

homes. Sometimes he's successful. On occasion, he uses people to make our homes miserable, and in some cases to completely ruin our families. Here are two areas that immediately come to mind:

By getting one of the family members to sin. If Satan is able to lead one of the family members into sin, it is often that he can lead the whole family to ruin. "And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat" (Gen. 3:6).

By keeping families from spending time together. It is good for members of the family to spend time together. When we do not enjoy togetherness, our family unit is weakened. Consider the story of Samuel. Samuel was a

godly man, but his sons, when they were grown, "...walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted judgment" (1 Sam. 8:3). How could such a godly man lose his own family? Perhaps the answer can be found in 1 Samuel 7:16. "And he went from year to year in circuit to Bethel, and Gilgal, and Mizpeh, and judged Israel in all those places." Could it be possible that Samuel spent so much time dealing with the problems of others, that he lost sight of the need to spend time with his own family?

If your family is in trouble. If the devil is putting asunder what God has joined together, what can be done? Decide that Christ will be the master of your home and your life. Seek the forgiveness of God and your family (Jas. 5:16). Correct the current situation. Ask others for help (counsel, prayer, etc.).

"Satan cannot defeat us so long as we are clinging to the cross." "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you..." (Jas. 4:7-8).


