## Updated WACS are Well-Informed, Achievable with Support, and Child Focused!

The Washington Administrative Code (WAC) rules for early learning (center and family home child care) are updated. The updated rules, are in Chapter 110-300, WAC Foundational Quality Standards for Early Learning Programs, available at <a href="http://apps.leg.wa.gov/wac/default.aspx?cite=110-300">http://apps.leg.wa.gov/wac/default.aspx?cite=110-300</a>. They go into effect on August 1, 2019.



The updated WACS are well-informed: The Early Start Act, passed in 2015, required Washington to align licensing, Early Achievers and Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program (ECEAP). Through the work of an active Advisory Committee, 45 community meetings, 10 multi-day negotiated rulemaking sessions with teams of parents, providers, and licensors, and over 2000 public comments, these revised, updated WACS are well-informed by a large, engaged, and diverse group of people in Washington state who contributed their ideas, expertise and experience.

The updated WACS are achievable with support: These revised, updated WACS are achievable by the provider community, with advance support and information coming from DCYF so that providers are prepared for the August 2019 implementation date. Videos and webinars started in October, 2018, and deep dive education is starting in 2019.


