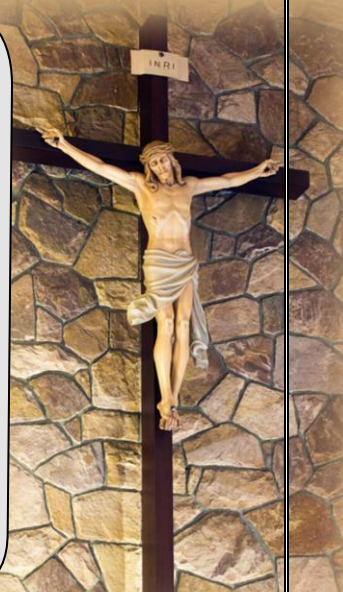

The government has not replaced the abortion prohibition with any law at all - Canada is one of only three countries on earth that does not limit abortion in some way.
