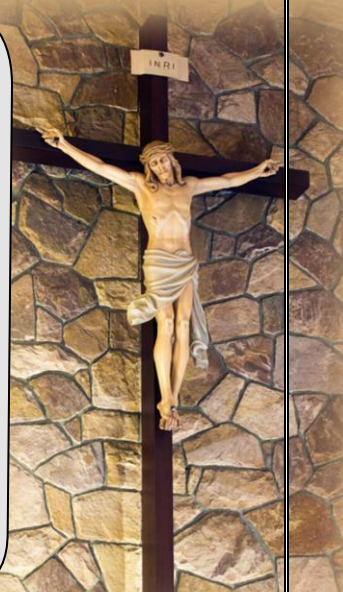

ABORTION IN CANADA: On May 14, 1969 Canada decriminalized abortion by taking it out of the Criminal Code. The government has not replaced the abortion prohibition with any law at all - Canada is one of only three countries on earth that does not limit abortion in some way. In the last 49 years, over 3 million babies have been aborted in our country. Moreover, our Alberta government has proposed a law to further limit our right to pray peacefully outside the Kensington abortion clinic. Do you believe that abortion is murder?
