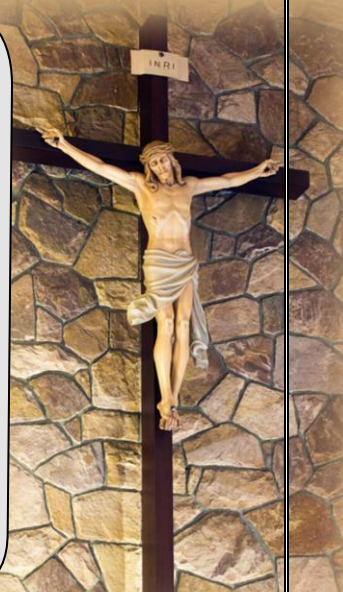

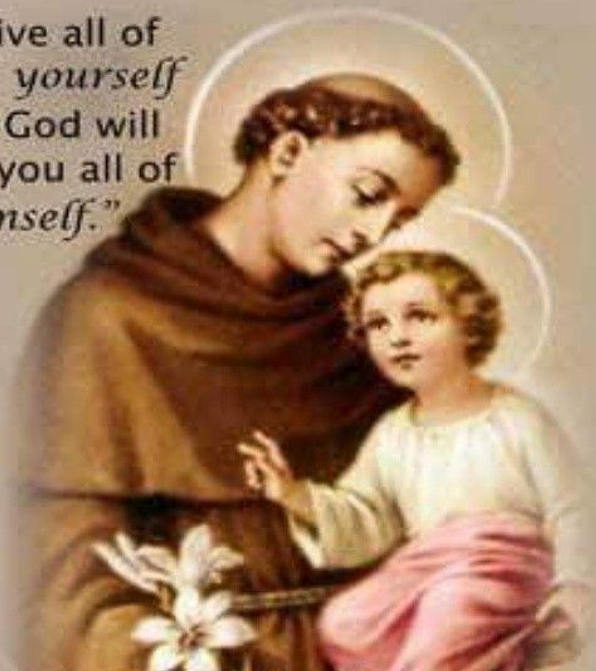
FR. JACK'S CHUCKLE
